


**Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors** 




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




**Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations** 







### 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Alleghany County had the 11th lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,057**. Between 2018 and 2019, Alleghany County had the second largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at 1.5 percentage points.

Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Alleghany County had the 12<sup>th</sup> lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,494. Alleghany County had the ninth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 36.






### 2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

10.3% of Alleghany County felony charges were for violent felonies, 50.8% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 38.9% were for other nonviolent felonies.






