
**Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations** 




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors





Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors










Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Anson County had the second highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,046. Between 2018 and 2019, Anson County had the 14<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .2 percentage points.





**Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies** 





## Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies

Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Anson County had the eighth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **619**. Between 2018 and 2019, Anson County had the fifth highest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **6.0** percentage points.
