

66.2% of Beaufort County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 23.0% were for other nonviolent offenses, 5.6% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.0% were for violent offenses, and .2% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.




Nonviolent, Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanor Charges




Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors










2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100.000 Population







Among micropolitan counties¹, Beaufort County had the seventh highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **831**. Between 2018 and 2019, Beaufort County had the ninth largest decrease in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **.04** percentage points.
