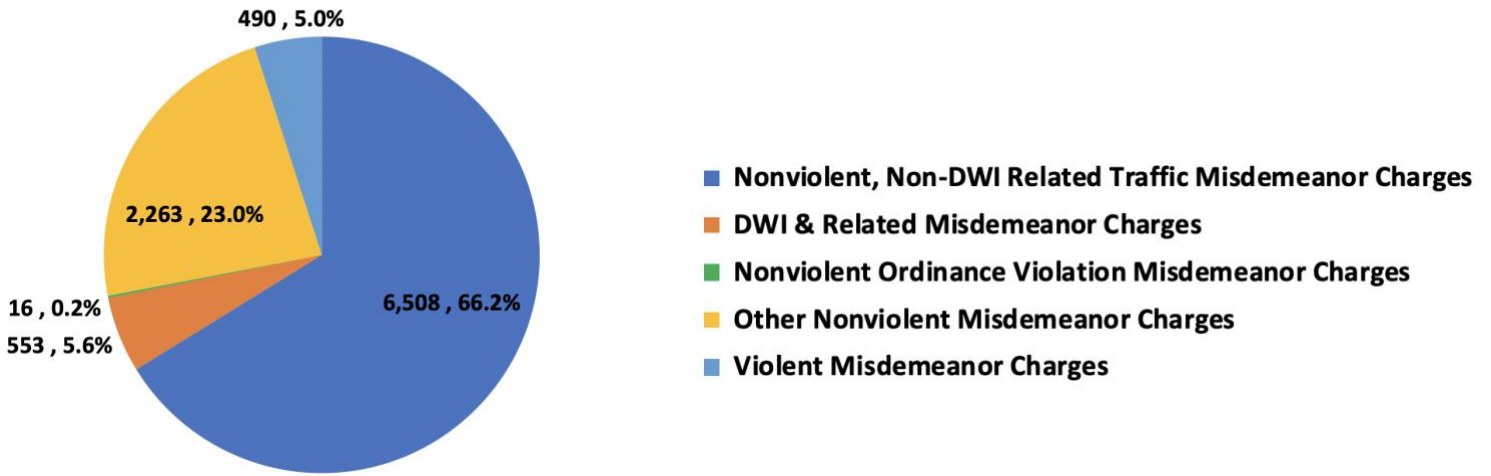
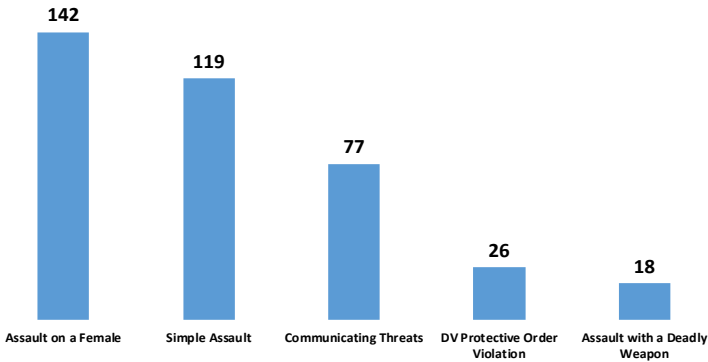


66.2% of Beaufort County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 23.0% were for other nonviolent offenses, 5.6% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.0% were for violent offenses, and .2% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

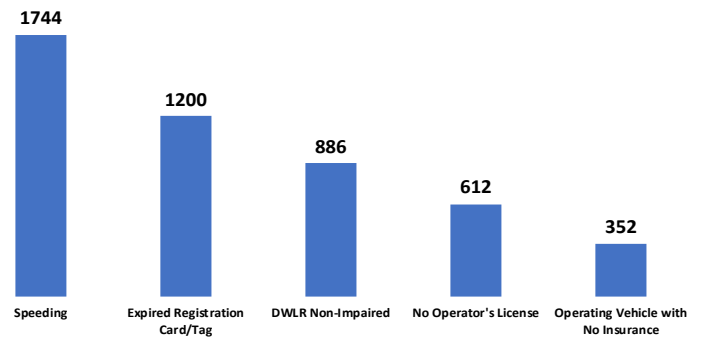
2019 Charged Misdemeanors



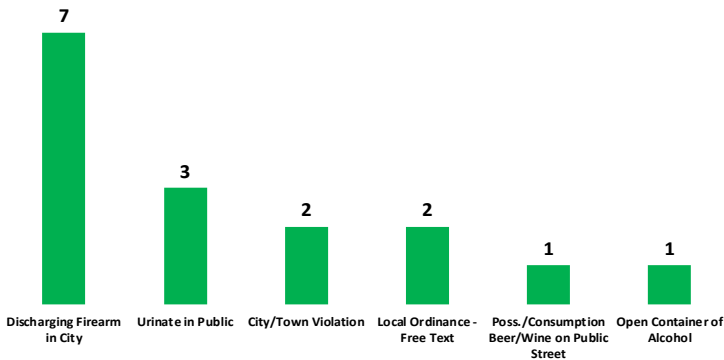
Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



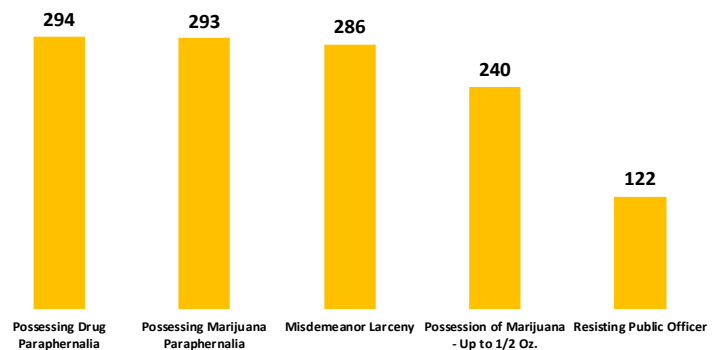
Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



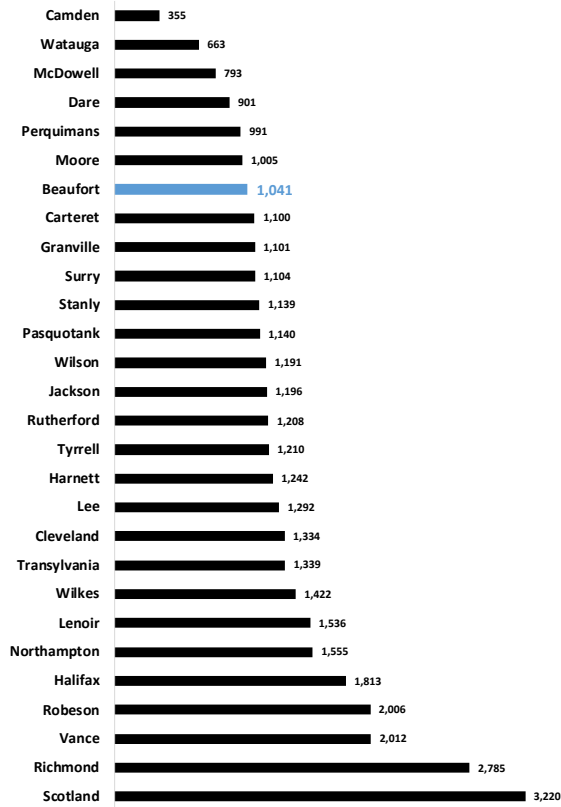
Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



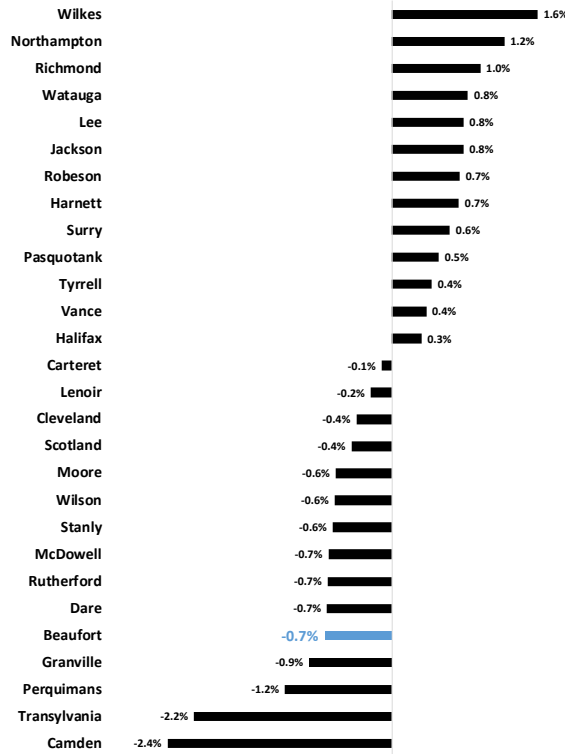
Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors



2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Micropolitan Counties

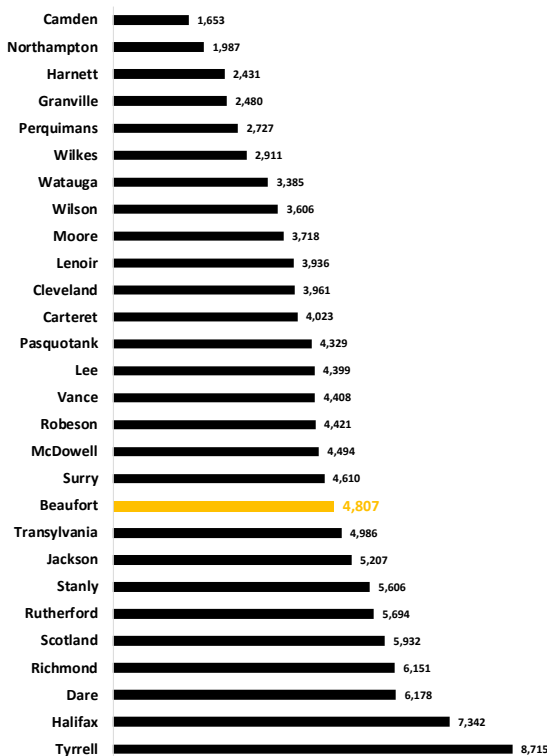


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Micropolitan Counties

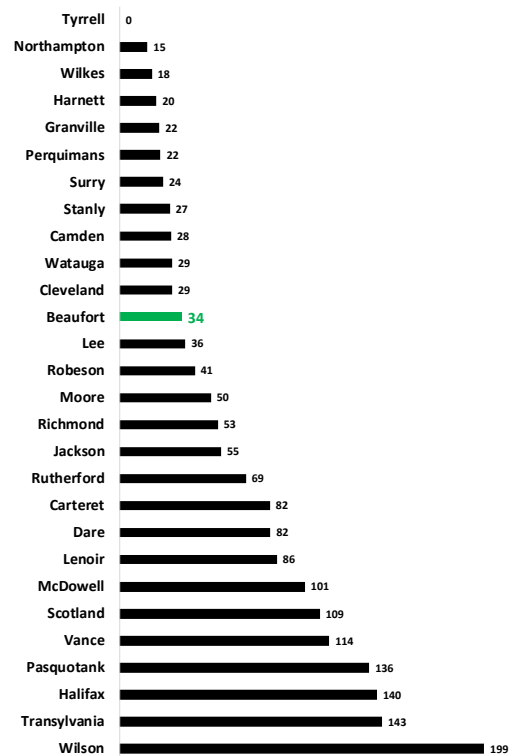


Among micropolitan counties¹, Beaufort County had the seventh lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,041**. Between 2018 and 2019, Beaufort County had the fifth largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at **.7** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Micropolitan Counties

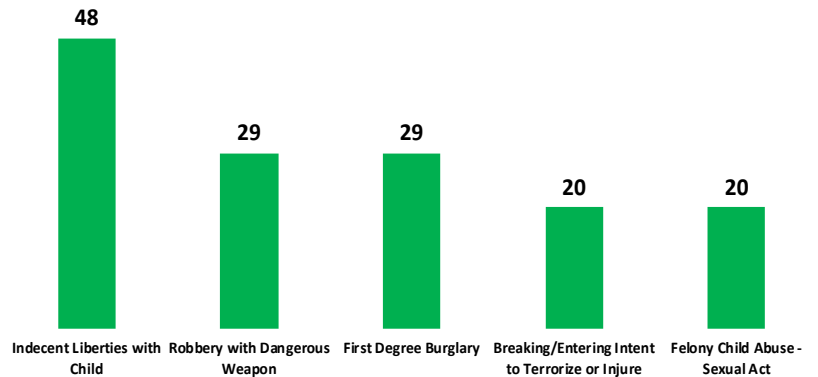


Among micropolitan counties¹, Beaufort County had the 10th highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **4,807**. Beaufort County had the 12th lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **34**.

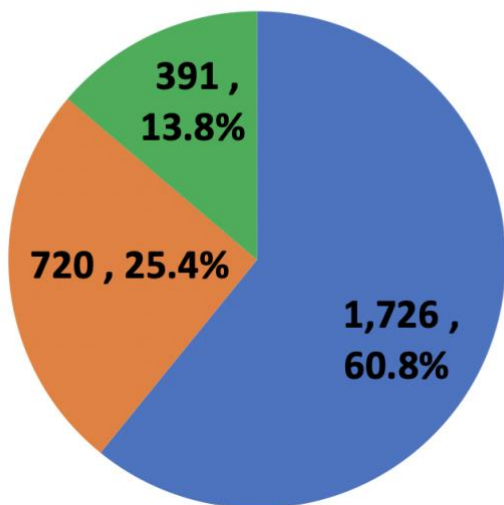

Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

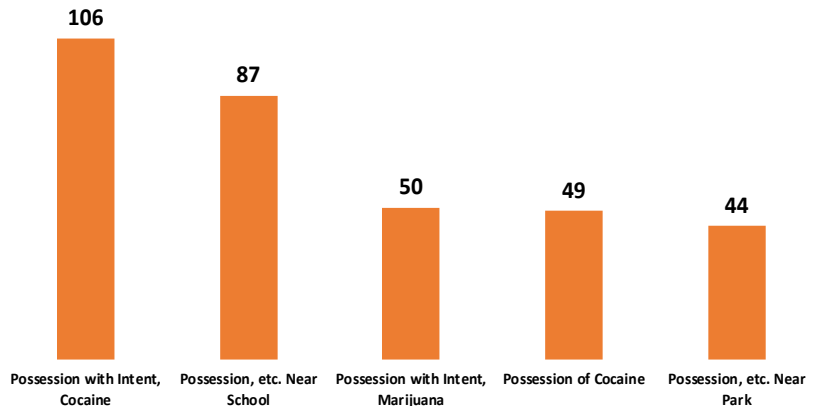

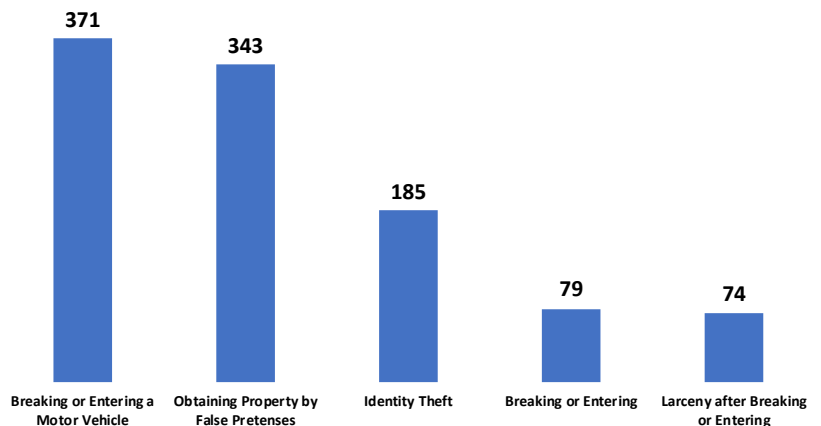

Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies



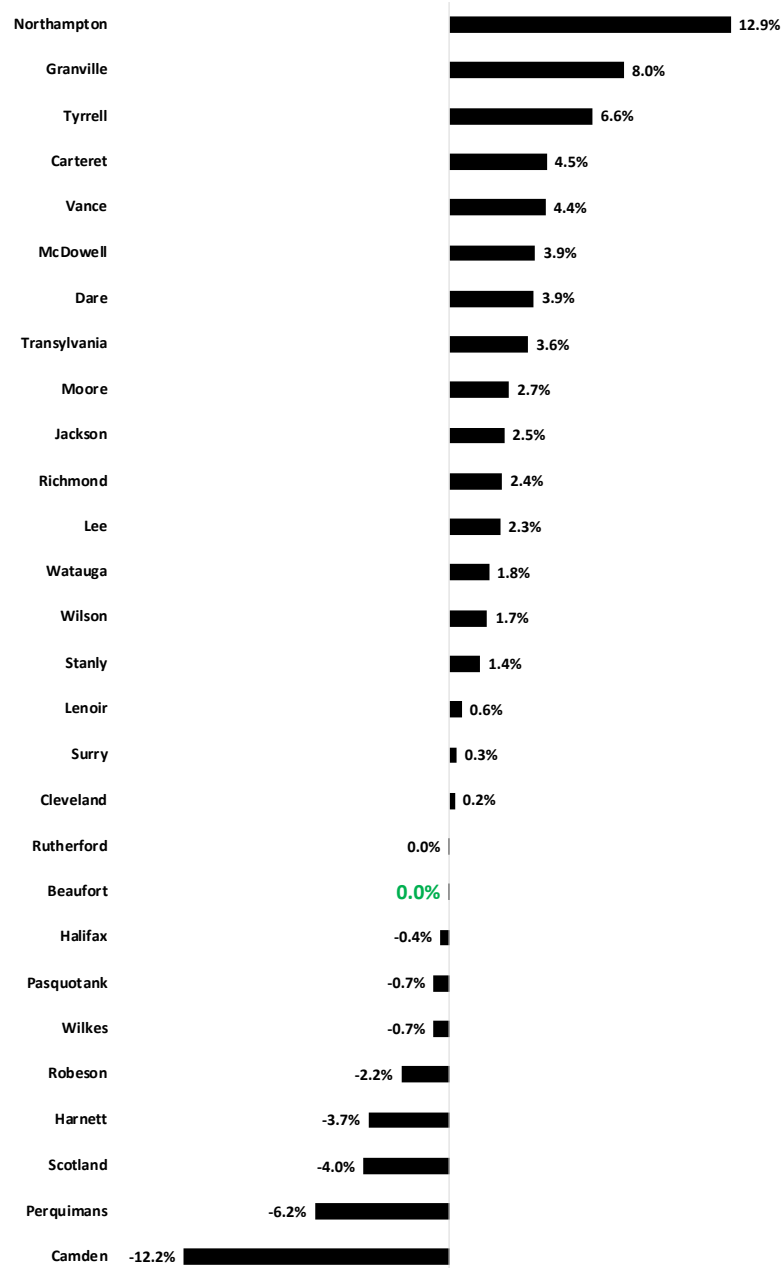
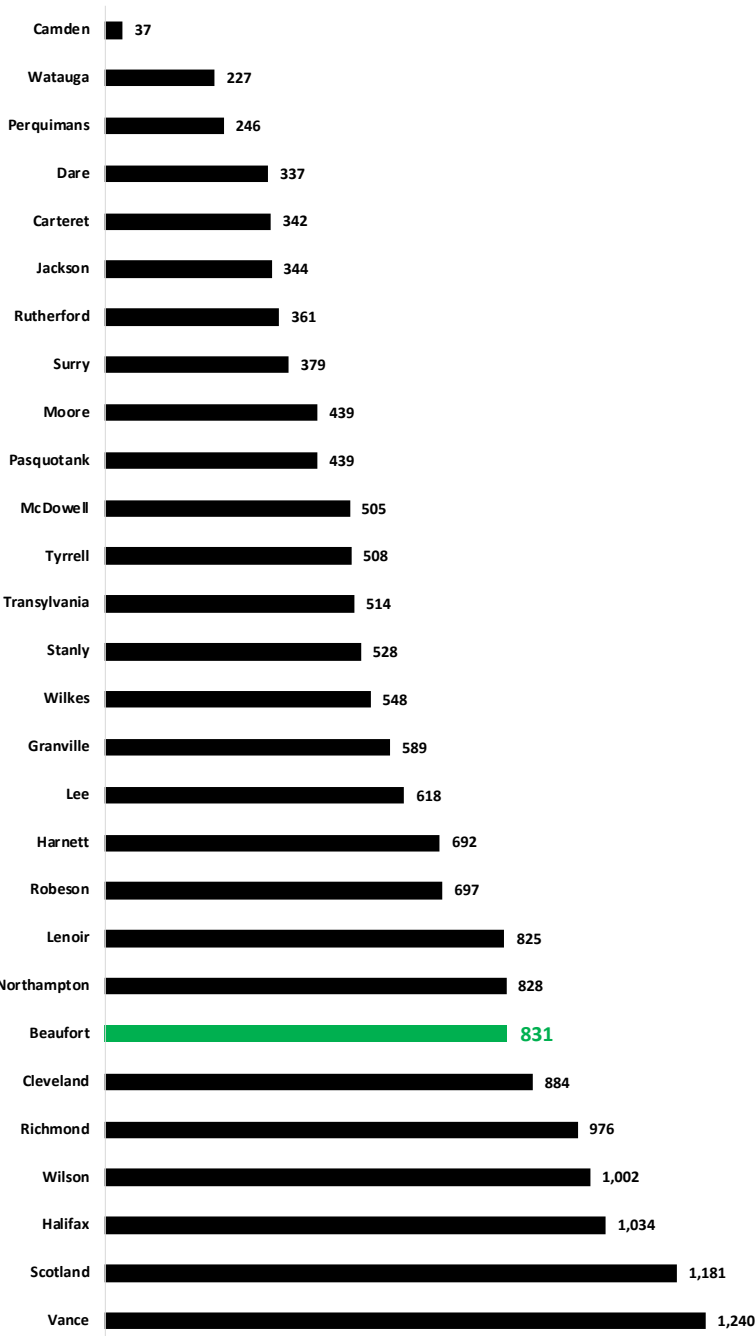
Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies



Among micropolitan counties¹, Beaufort County had the seventh highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **831**. Between 2018 and 2019, Beaufort County had the ninth largest decrease in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **.04** percentage points.
