



**79.0%** of Bertie County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **11.7%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **3.4%** were for DWI and related offenses, **5.6%** were for violent offenses, and **.2%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.




**Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors** 




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




**Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations** 







## 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties






Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Bertie County had the 10<sup>th</sup> highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,204. Between 2018 and 2019, Bertie County had the 12<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .5 percentage points.

Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Bertie County had the fifth lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,502. Bertie County had the fifth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 53.







**Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies** 

16.8% of Bertie County felony charges were for violent felonies, 34.7% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 48.5% were for other nonviolent felonies.








- Nonviolent Felonies, Other

## **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**



Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Bertie County had the 10<sup>th</sup> lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **352**. Between 2018 and 2019, Bertie County had the third largest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **6.5** percentage points.
