



**79.7%** of Bladen County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **12.6%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **3.4%** were for DWI and related offenses, **4.3%** were for violent offenses, and **.1%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.


### 2019 Charged Misdemeanors




#### **Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors**




# Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors





### **Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations**



#### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors**











Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Bladen County had the 11<sup>th</sup> highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,100. Between 2018 and 2019, Bladen County had the ninth largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .4 percentage points.


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Bladen County had the 10<sup>th</sup> lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,242. Bladen County had the ninth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 18.






**Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies** 





#### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**



Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Bladen County had the eighth lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **301**. Between 2018 and 2019, Bladen County had the 10<sup>th</sup> largest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **4.1** percentage points.
