

68.2% of Burke County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **20.7%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.3%** were for DWI and related offenses, **6.6%** were for violent offenses, and **.1%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.
















Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors





2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Medium Metro Counties



Among medium metro counties¹, Burke County had the 12th lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,021. Between 2018 and 2019, Burke County had the 10th largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .2 percentage points.

Among medium metro counties¹, Burke County had the eighth lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,178. Burke County had the fourth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 14.



2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor






