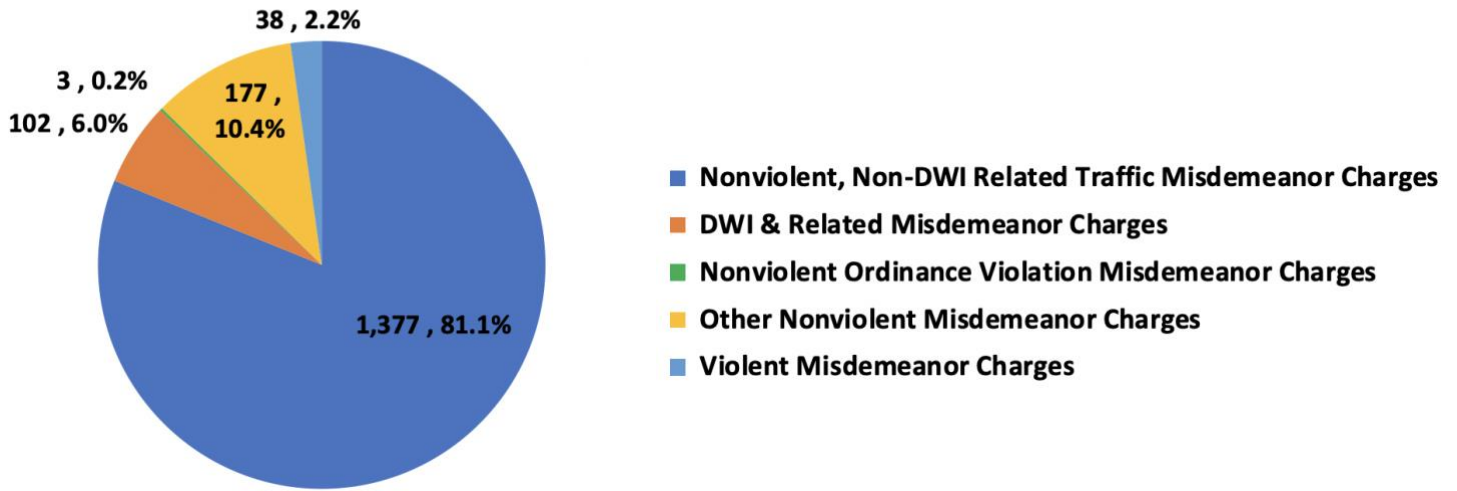
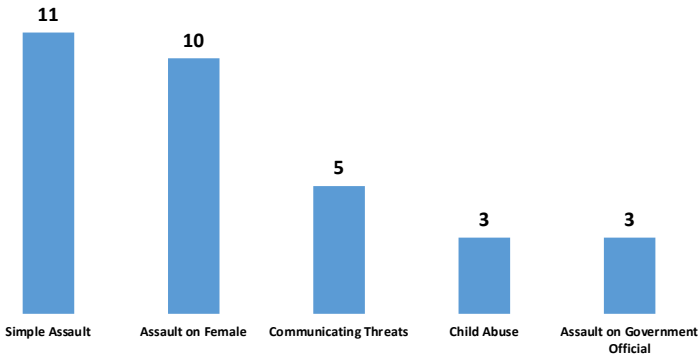


81.1% of Camden County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 10.4% were for other nonviolent offenses, 6.0% were for DWI and related offenses, 2.2% were for violent offenses, and .2% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

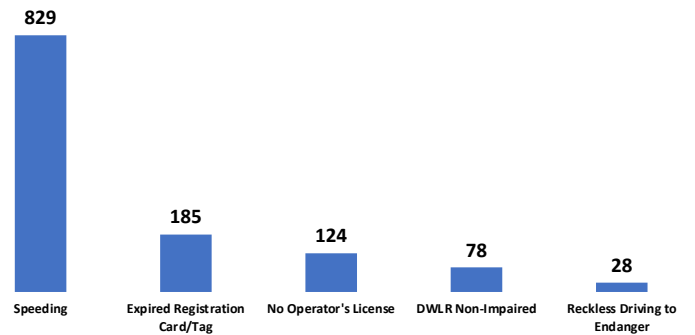
2019 Charged Misdemeanors



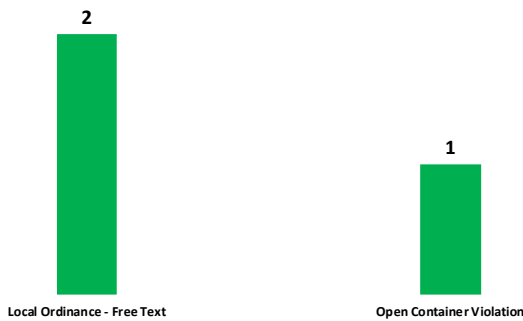
Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



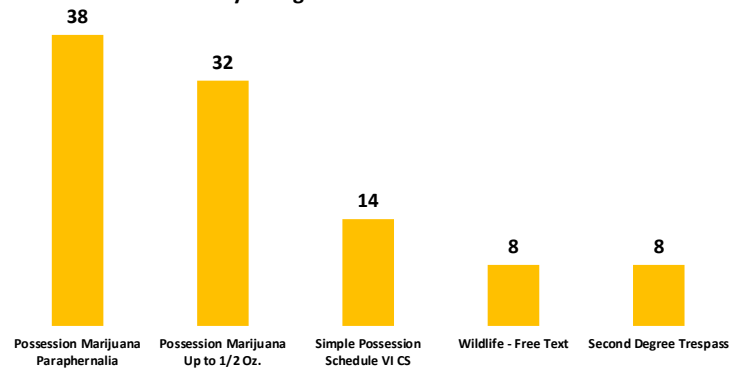
Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



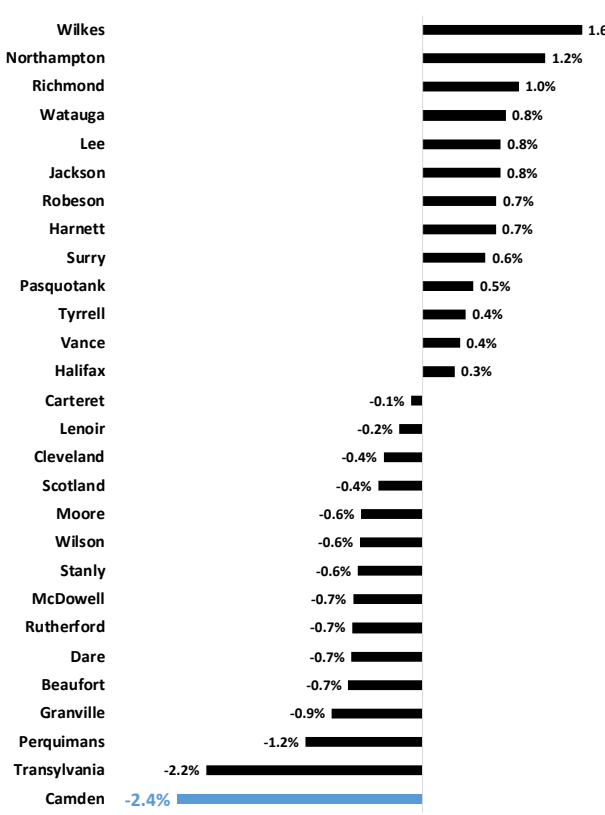
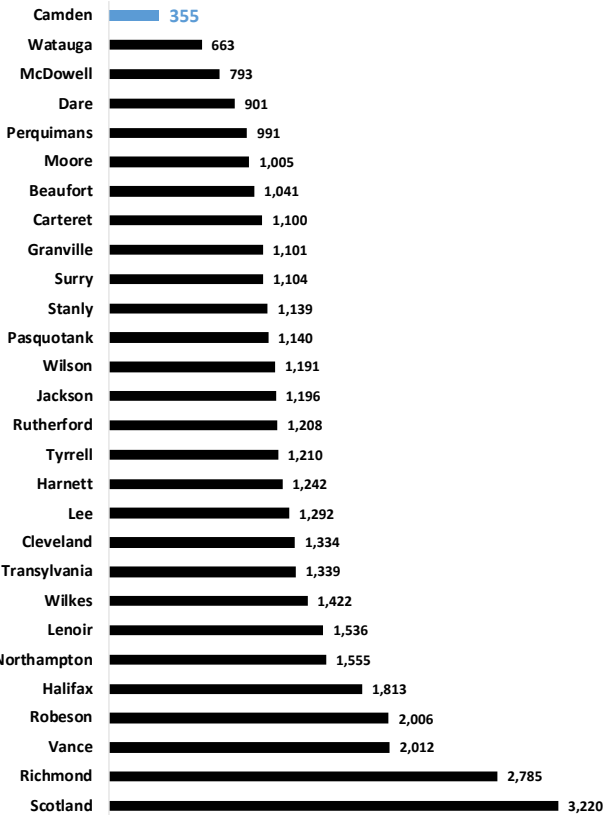

2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties

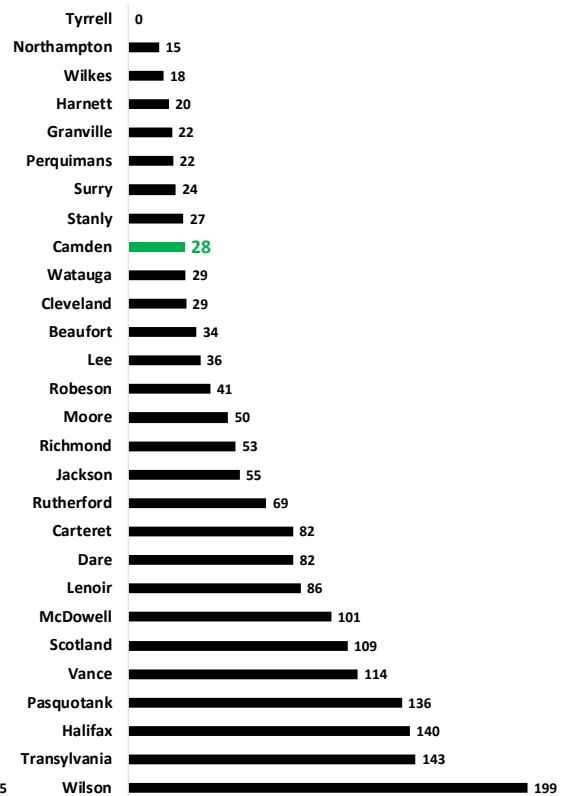
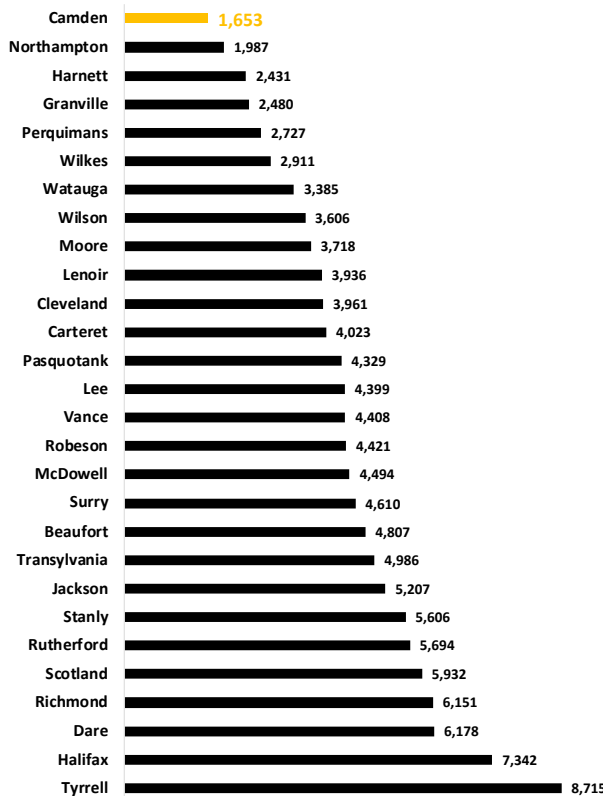
Among micropolitan counties¹, Camden County had the lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **355**. Between 2018 and 2019, Camden County had the largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at **2.4** percentage points.

Among micropolitan counties¹, Camden County had the lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,653**. Camden County had the ninth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **28**.



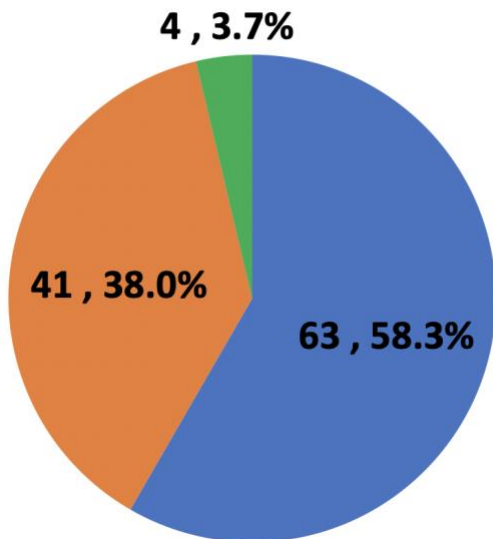

Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

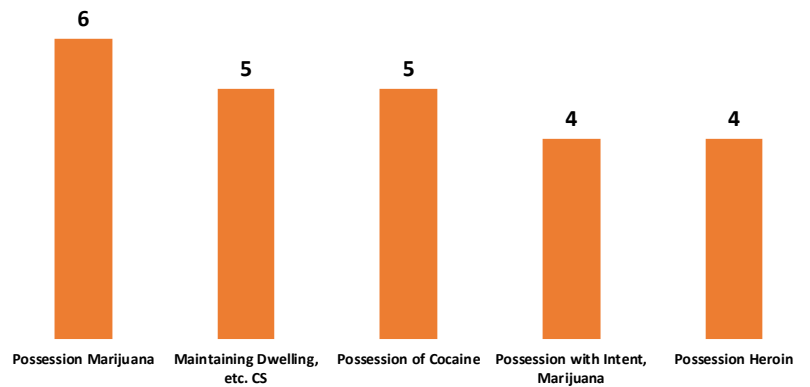

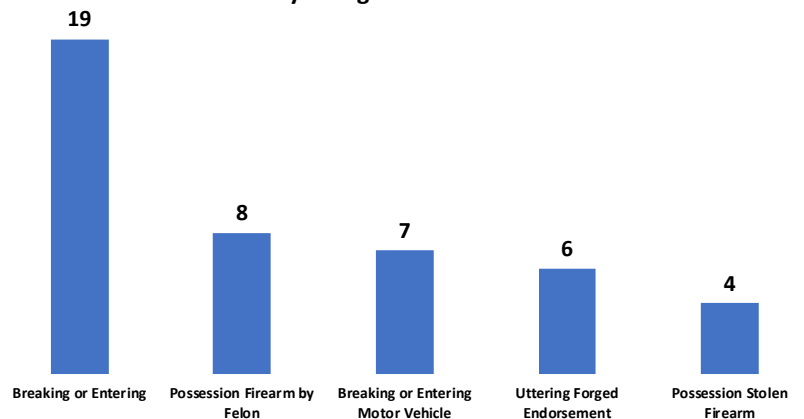

Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies

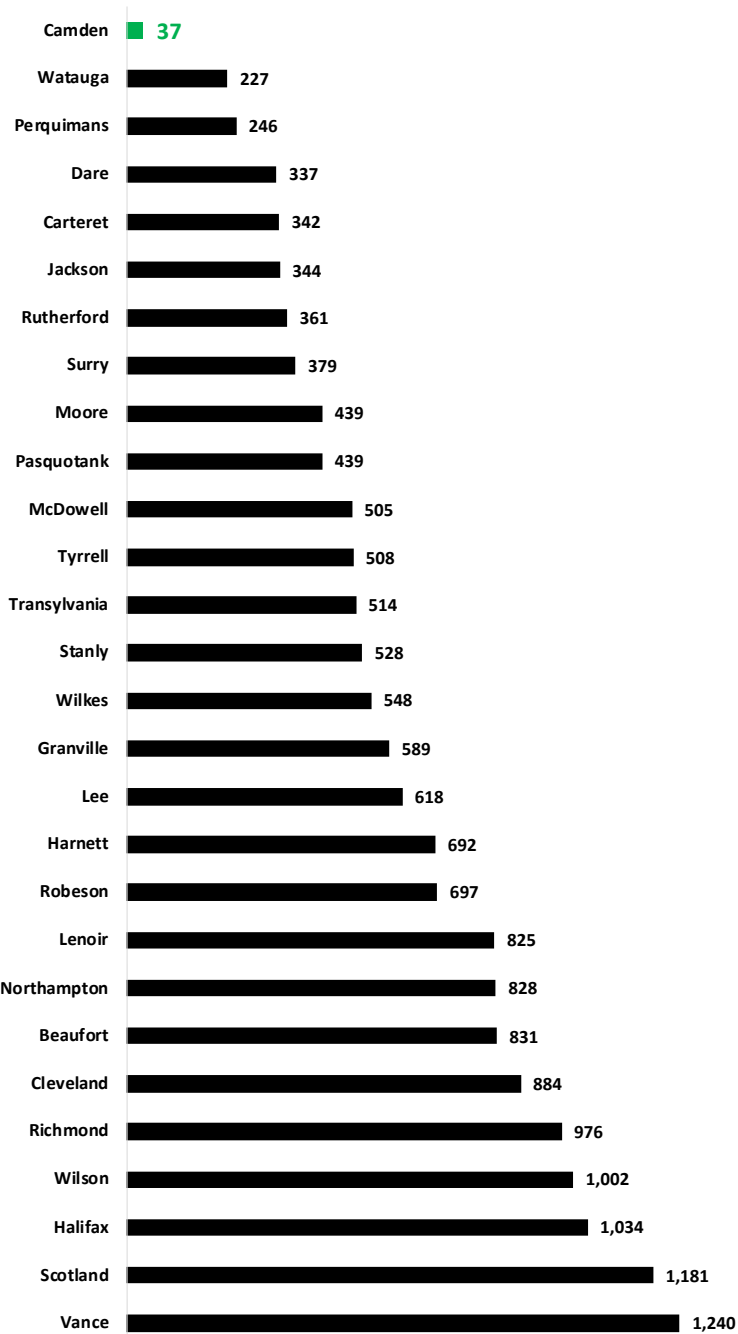

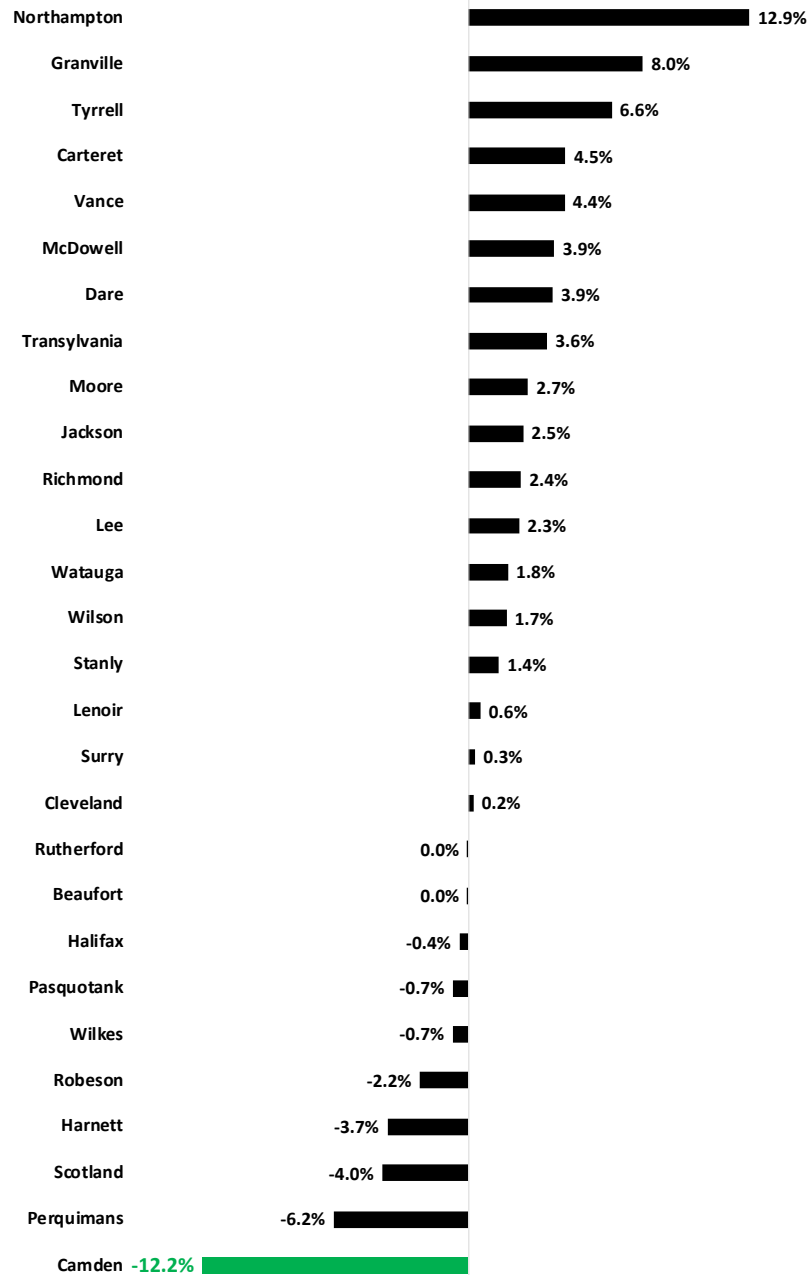


Among micropolitan counties¹, Camden County had the lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **37**. Between 2018 and 2019, Camden County had the largest decrease in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **12.2** percentage points.
