
2019 Charged Misdemeanors













2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties






Among micropolitan 1.6% counties¹, Camden County had the lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 355. Between 2018 and 2019, Camden County had the largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at 2.4 percentage points.


2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

Among micropolitan counties¹, Camden County had the lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,653. Camden County had the ninth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 28.





3.7% of Camden County felony charges were for violent felonies, **38.0%** were for nonviolent drug felonies, and **58.3%** were for other nonviolent felonies.


Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies




2019 Charged Felonies





Among micropolitan counties¹, Camden County had the lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **37**. Between 2018 and 2019, Camden County had the largest decrease in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **12.2** percentage points.
