
**58.8%** of Carteret County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **25.6%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **8.0%** were for DWI and related offenses, **7.0%** were for violent offenses, and **.5%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.








Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Carteret County had the eighth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,100. Between 2018 and 2019, Carteret County had the 15<sup>th</sup> largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at .1 percentage points.

Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Carteret County had the 12<sup>th</sup> lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,023. Carteret County had the 10<sup>th</sup> highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 82.





2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties


2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties


