









## 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor **Charges Among Noncore Counties**




Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Caswell County had the second lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 709. Between 2018 and 2019, Caswell County had the largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at 3.1 percentage points.


2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population




## **2019 Charged Felonies**






- Nonviolent Felonies, Other

## Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies



Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Caswell County had the 11<sup>th</sup> lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **383**. Between 2018 and 2019, Caswell County had the second largest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **10.7** percentage points.
