



**72.4%** of Catawba County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **18.2%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **3.4%** were for DWI and related offenses, **5.6%** were for violent offenses, and **.4%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.




**Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors** 




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic




**Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations** 




**Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors** 




## 2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Medium Metro Counties






Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Catawba County had the ninth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 987. Between 2018 and 2019, Catawba County had the fifth largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at 1.1 percentage points.


Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Catawba County had the ninth lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **3,216**. Catawba County had the ninth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **69**.






12.4% of Catawba County felony charges were for violent felonies, 31.5% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 56.1% were for other nonviolent felonies.




### **Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies**



#### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**



Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Catawba County had the third lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 250. Between 2018 and 2019, Catawba County had the fourth largest increase in violent felony charges among medium metro counties at 2.3 percentage points.
