

57.7% of Cherokee County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **28.1%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.8%** were for DWI and related offenses, **9.2%** were for violent offenses, and **.2%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.








Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




Among noncore counties¹, Cherokee County had the seventh highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,349. Between 2018 and 2019, Cherokee County had the ninth largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .7 percentage points.







Among noncore counties¹, Cherokee County had the seventh lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **296**. Between 2018 and 2019, Cherokee County had the 11th largest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **3.1** percentage points.
