



65.9% of Cleveland County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 22.7% were for other nonviolent offenses, 3.6% were for DWI and related offenses, 7.6% were for violent offenses, and .2% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.




#### Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




#### Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




#### Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations





2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties




2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Cleveland County had the 10<sup>th</sup> highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,334**. Between 2018 and 2019, Cleveland County had the 13<sup>th</sup> largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at **.4** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties



Cleveland County had the 11<sup>th</sup> lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **29**.



Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies










Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Cleveland County had the sixth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **884**. Between 2018 and 2019, Cleveland County had the 18<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **.2** percentage points.
