



66.1% of Edgecombe County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 20.4% were for other nonviolent offenses, 4.9% were for DWI and related offenses, 8.2% were for violent offenses, and .4% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.


2019 Charged Misdemeanors






Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors











Among small metro counties1, **Edgecombe County** had the highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,740. Between 2018 and 2019, **Edgecombe County** had the third largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .5 percentage points.


Among small metro counties¹, **Edgecombe County** had the fourth highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,325. Edgecombe County had the third highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 81.










2019 Charged Felonies






- Nonviolent Felonies, Other
