




72.6% of Franklin County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **18.0%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **6.0%** were for DWI and related offenses, **3.2%** were for violent offenses, and **0.1%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.


















Among large central and large fringe metro counties^{1,2}, Franklin County had the lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 525. Between 2018 and 2019, Franklin County had the fourth largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .5 percentage points.

Among large central and large fringe metro counties^{1,2}, Franklin County had the sixth highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,925. Franklin County had the fourth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 16.






7.8% of Franklin County felony charges were for violent felonies, **63.3%** were for nonviolent drug felonies, and **28.9%** were for other nonviolent felonies.




2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies

Among large central metro counties¹ and large fringe metro counties², Franklin County had the third lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 367. Between 2018 and 2019, Franklin County had the third largest decrease in violent felony charges at .5 percentage points.
