


69.3% of Gaston County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 21.0% were for other nonviolent offenses, 3.9% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.3% were for violent offenses, and 0.5% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.


2019 Charged Misdemeanors








Among large central and large fringe metro counties^{1,2}, **Gaston County had** the highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,125**. Between 2018 and 2019, Gaston County had the third largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .6 percentage points.

Among large central and large fringe metro counties^{1,2}, **Gaston County had** the highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,471. Gaston County had the fourth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 110.










2019 Charged Felonies






- Nonviolent Felonies, OtherNonviolent Drug Felonies

Among large central metro counties¹ and large fringe metro counties², Gaston County had the fifth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 495. Between 2018 and 2019, Gaston County had the fourth largest decrease in violent felony charges at .2 percentage points.
