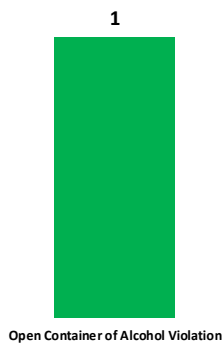


47.1 % of Graham County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 30.2% were for other nonviolent offenses, 5.8% were for DWI and related offenses, 16.7% were for violent offenses, and .1% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

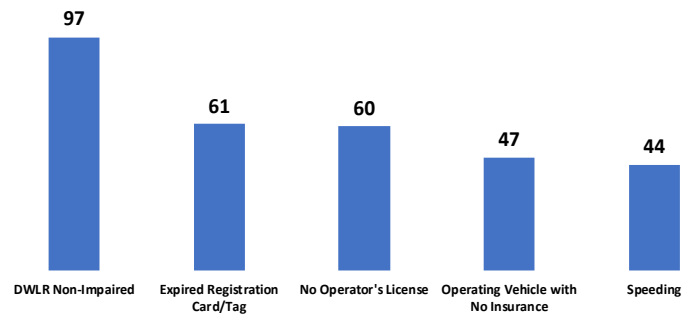

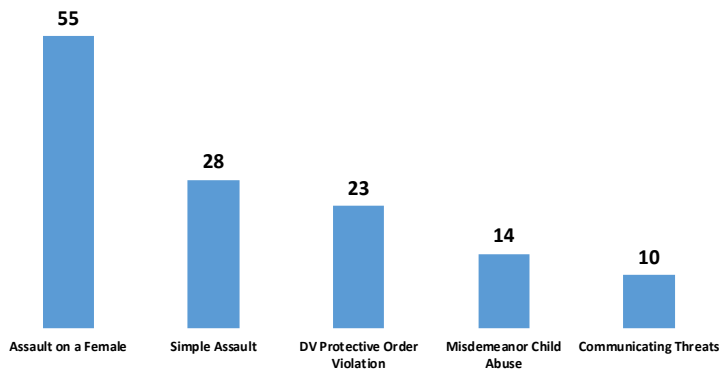
Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



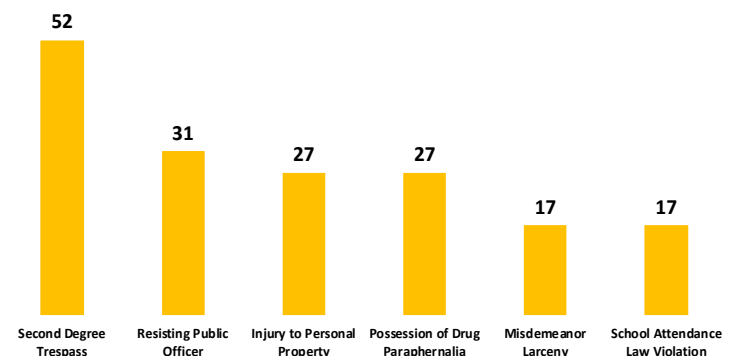
Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



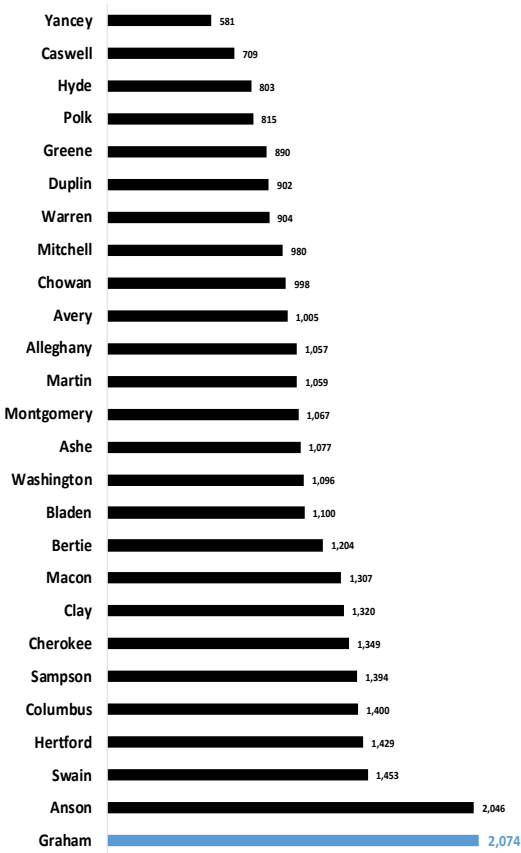
Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



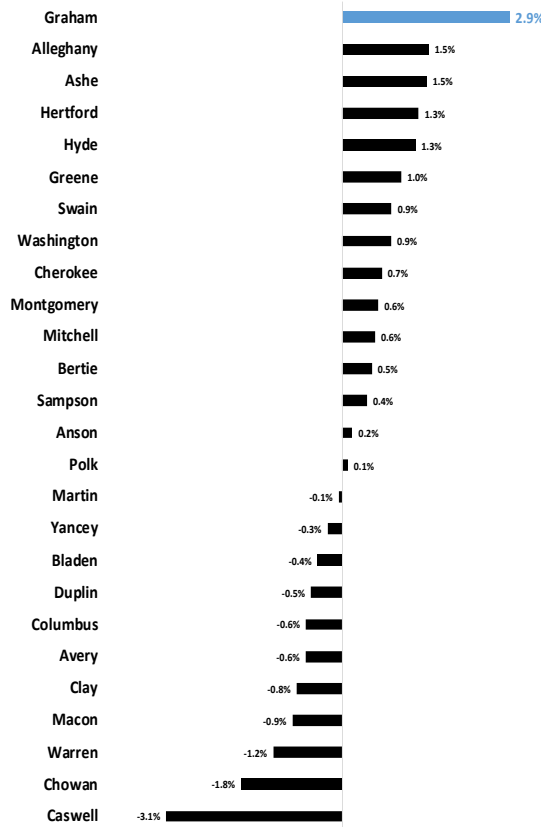
Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors



2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

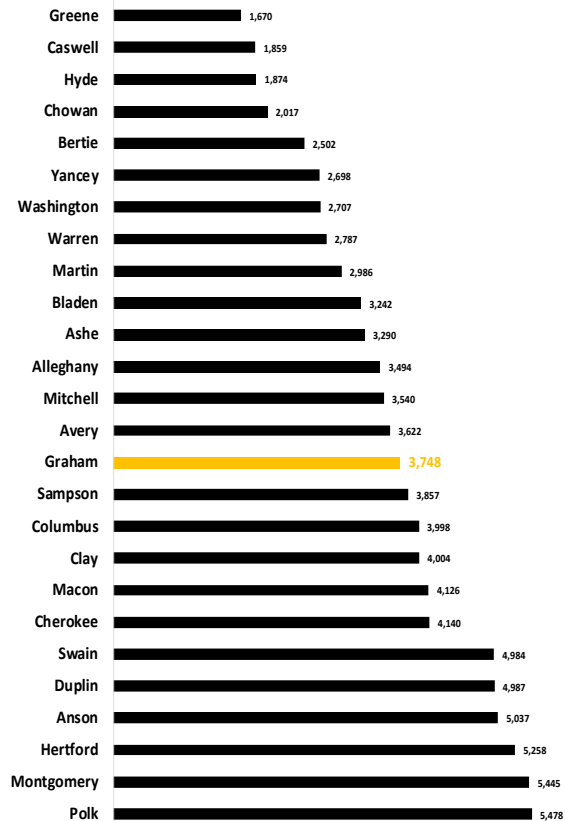


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties

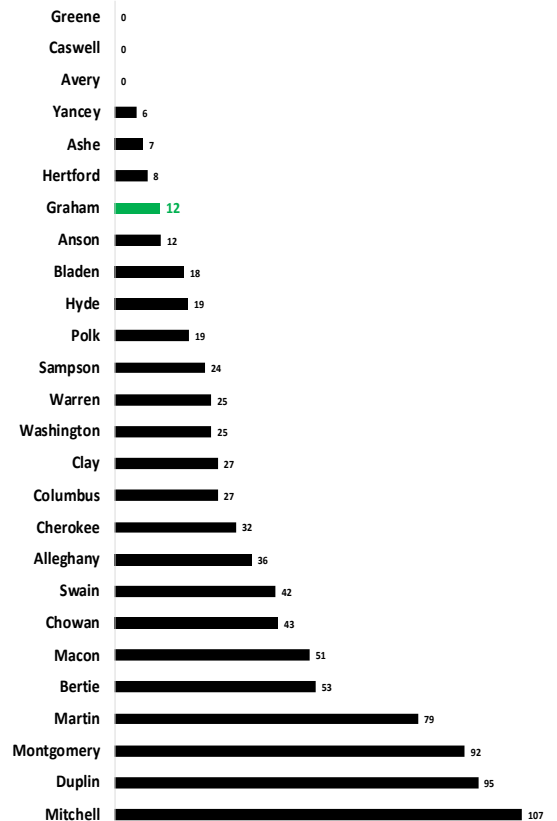


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Graham County had the highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **2,074**. Between 2018 and 2019, Graham County had the largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at **2.9** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

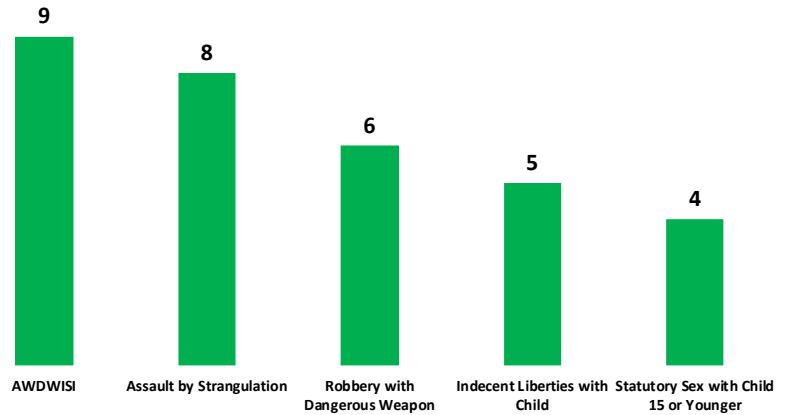


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Graham County had the 12<sup>th</sup> highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **3,748**. Graham County had the seventh lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **12**.

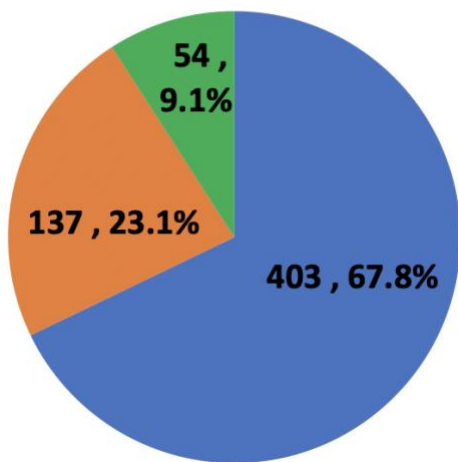

Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

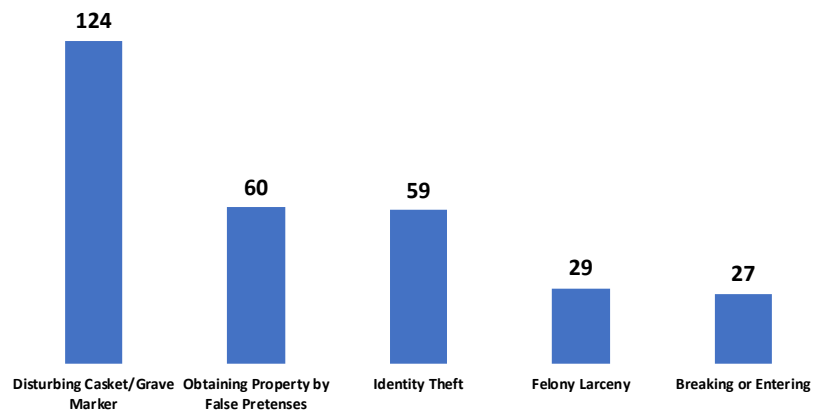

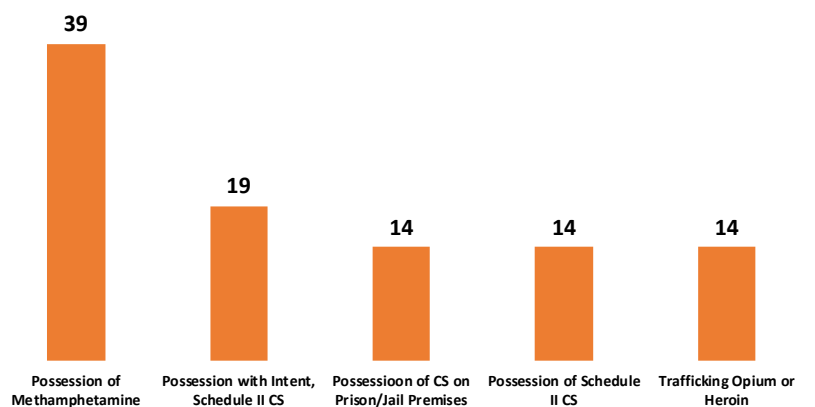

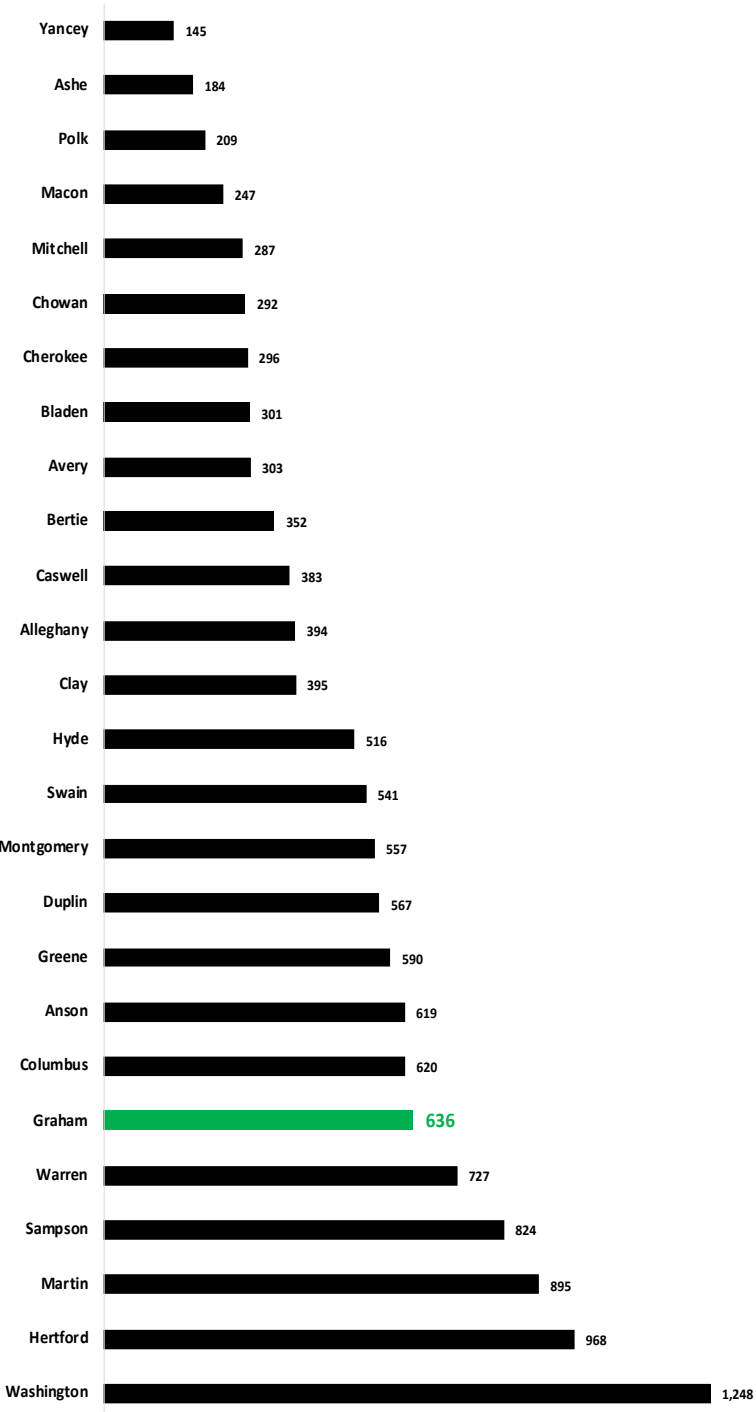


Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies

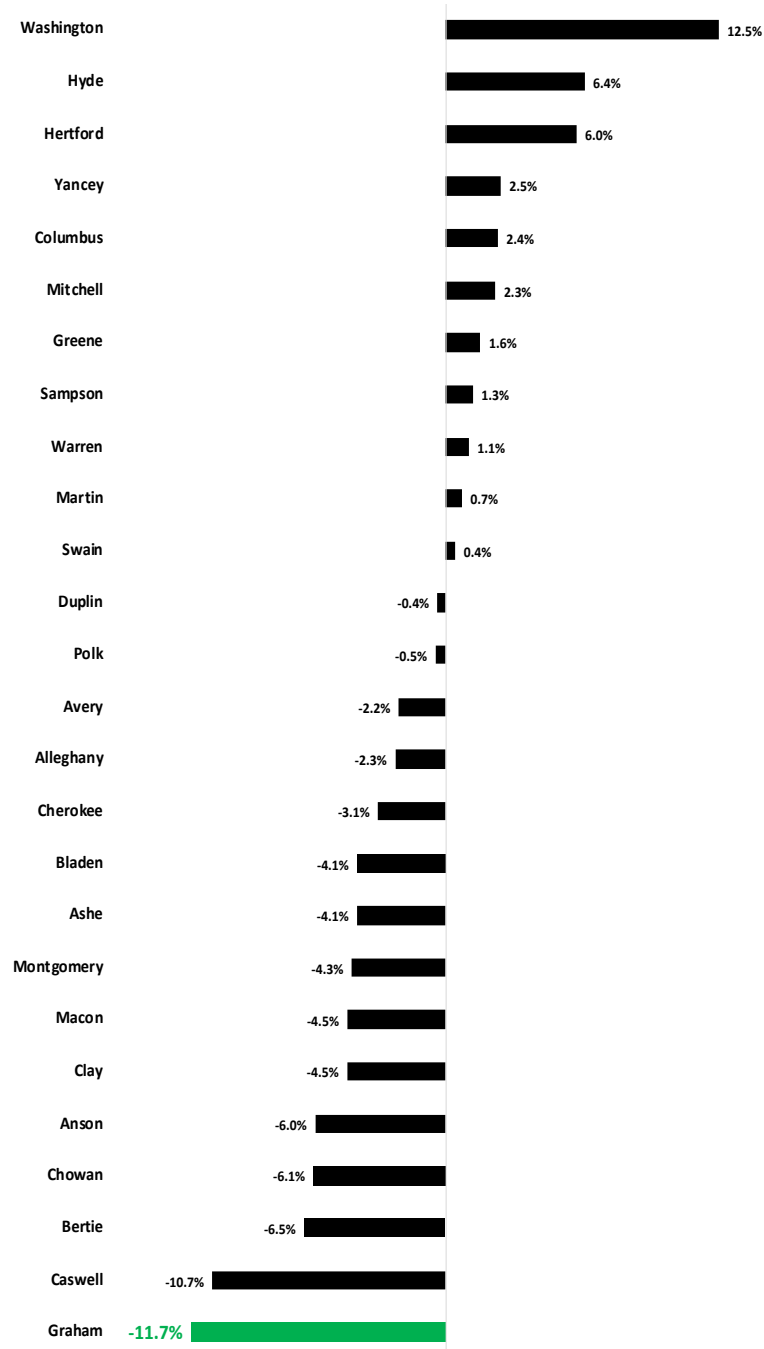


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Graham County had the sixth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **636**. Between 2018 and 2019, Graham County had the largest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **11.7** percentage points.
