


**47.1** % of Graham County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **30.2**% were for other nonviolent offenses, **5.8**% were for DWI and related offenses, **16.7**% were for violent offenses, and **.1**% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.






Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic





#### 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Graham County had the highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,074. Between 2018 and 2019, Graham County had the largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at 2.9 percentage points.

Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Graham County had the 12<sup>th</sup> highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,748. Graham County had the seventh lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 12.














### **Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies**



Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Graham County had the sixth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 636. Between 2018 and 2019, Graham County had the largest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at 11.7 percentage points.
