


**67.2**% of Granville County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **16.1**% were for other nonviolent offenses, **9.5**% were for DWI and related offenses, **7.1**% were for violent offenses, and **.1**% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.


■ Nonviolent, Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanor Charges


DWI & Related Misdemeanor Charges






#### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors**











Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Granville County had the ninth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,101**. Between 2018 and 2019, Granville County had the fourth largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at .9 percentage points.



Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Granville County had the fourth lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,480. Granville County had the fifth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 22.











17.2% of Granville County felony charges were for violent felonies, 37.9% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 44.9% were for other nonviolent felonies.





### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**



Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Granville County had the 13<sup>th</sup> highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **589**. Between 2018 and 2019, Granville County had the second largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **8.0** percentage points.
