


### **2019 Charged Misdemeanors**




#### **Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors**




# Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors





#### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors**





#### 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties






Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Greene County had the fifth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 890. Between 2018 and 2019, Greene County had the sixth largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at 1.0 percentage points.


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Greene County had the lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,670. Greene County had the lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 0.






20.5% of Greene County felony charges were for violent felonies, 9.6% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 70.0% were for other nonviolent felonies.





#### **Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies**



Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Greene County had the ninth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **590**. Between 2018 and 2019, Greene County had the seventh largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **1.6** percentage points.
