


Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors




2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Medium Metro Counties



Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Haywood County had the second highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,543. Between 2018 and 2019, Haywood County had the 12<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .01 percentage points.



Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Haywood County had the 12<sup>th</sup> lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **447**. Between 2018 and 2019, Haywood County had the 10<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent felony charges among medium metro counties at **.8** percentage points.
