


**60.7%** of Henderson County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **27.5%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **5.0%** were for DWI and related offenses, **6.2%** were for violent offenses, and **.6%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

## 2019 Charged Misdemeanors




Nonviolent, Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanor Charges


DWI & Related Misdemeanor Charges


Nonviolent Ordinance Violation Misdemeanor Charges






















Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, **Henderson County** had the fourth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 858. Between 2018 and 2019, Henderson County had the seventh largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .4 percentage points.

Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, **Henderson County** had the 12th highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,782. Henderson County had the sixth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 84.













## 2019 Charged Felonies

Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Henderson County had the fourth lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 263. Between 2018 and 2019, Henderson County had the 11<sup>th</sup> largest decrease in violent felony charges among medium metro counties at .8 percentage points.
