




65.5% of Hoke County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 18.4% were for other nonviolent offenses, 3.4% were for DWI and related offenses, 12.5% were for violent offenses, and .2% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.











2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Medium Metro Counties


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Medium Metro Counties




Among medium metro counties¹, Hoke County had the highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,580. Between 2018 and 2019, Hoke County had the third largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .8 percentage points.

Among medium metro counties¹, Hoke County had the third lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,335. Hoke County had the eighth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 29.









12.1% of Hoke County felony charges were for violent felonies, 14.5% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 73.4% were for other nonviolent felonies.



2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies

Among medium metro counties¹, Hoke County had the seventh highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 535. Between 2018 and 2019, Hoke County had the eighth largest decrease in violent felony charges among medium metro counties at 1.1 percentage points.
