


**80.4%** of Jones County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **13.2%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **3.6%** were for DWI and related offenses, **2.8%** were for violent offenses, and **.0%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.



**Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors** 




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




**Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations** 



**Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors** 






Among small metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Jones County had the third highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,359**. Between 2018 and 2019, Jones County had the second largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .6 percentage points.


Among small metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Jones County had the highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 6,382. Jones County had the second lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 10.








17.0% of Jones County felony charges were for violent felonies, 50.1% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 33.0% were for other nonviolent felonies.




## 2019 Charged Felonies






Nonviolent Drug FeloniesNonviolent Felonies, OtherViolent Felonies



Among small metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Jones County had the highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,608**. Between 2018 and 2019, Jones County had the largest increase in violent felony charges at **7.6** percentage points.
