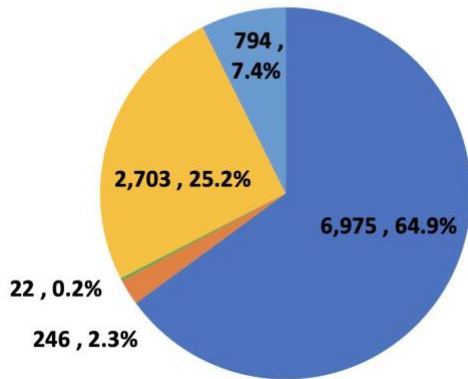


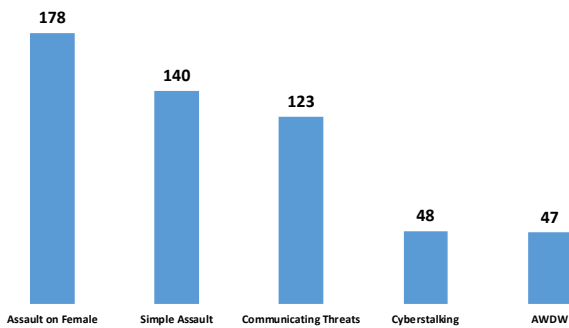
64.9% of Lee County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 25.2% were for other nonviolent offenses, 2.3% were for DWI and related offenses, 7.4% were for violent offenses, and .2% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

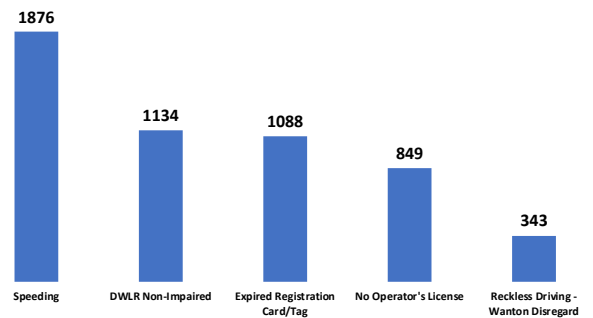

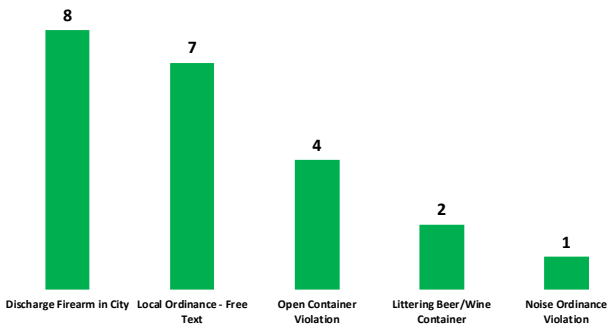
Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



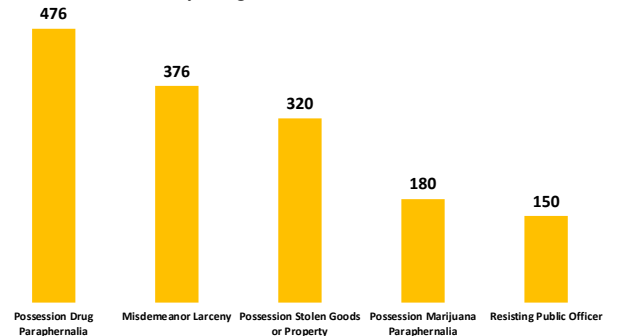
Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



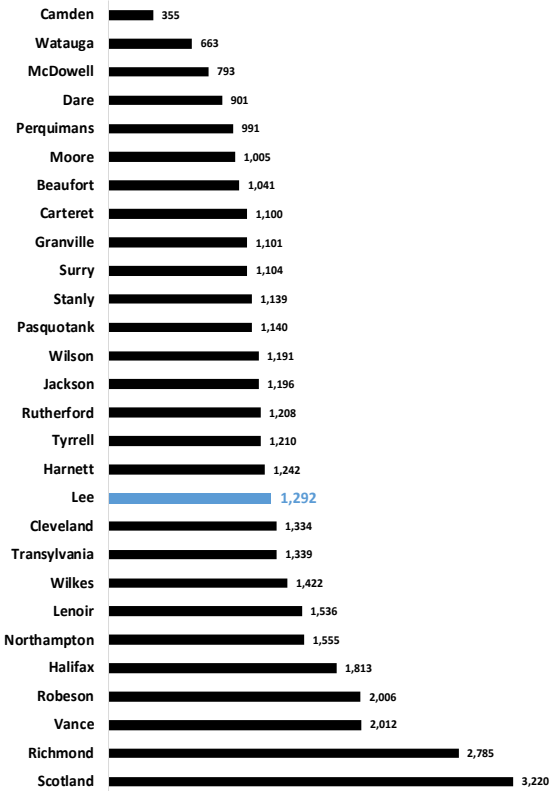
Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



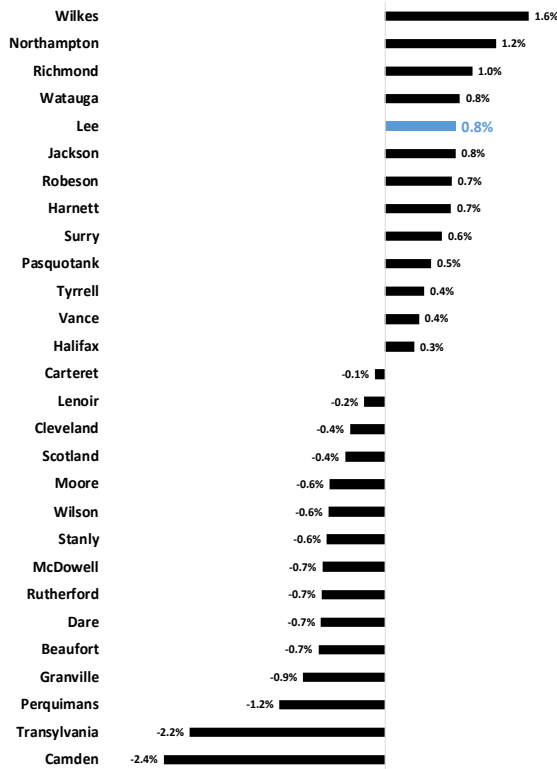
Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors



2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

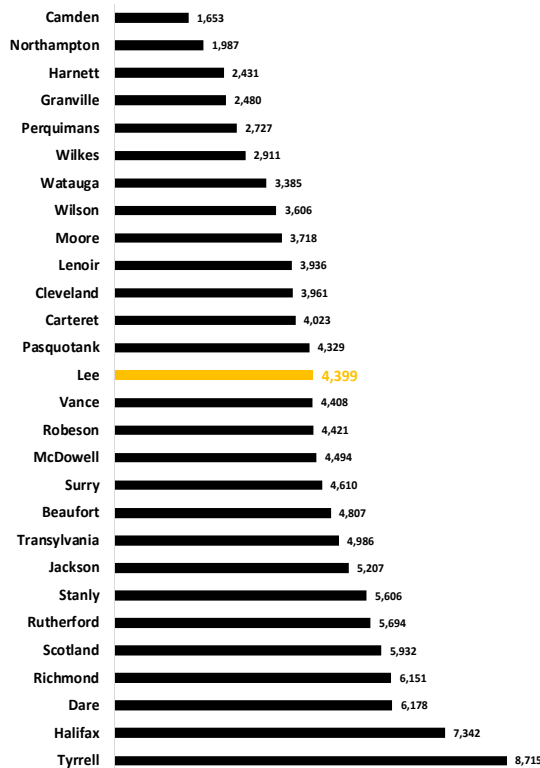


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties

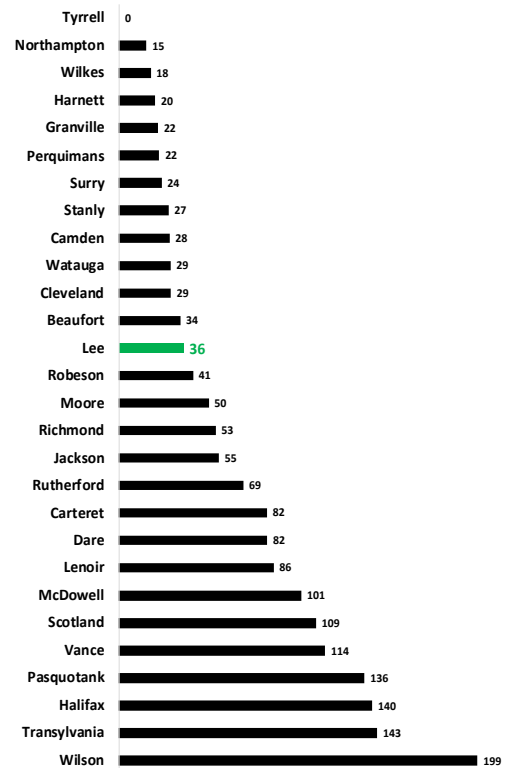


Among micropolitan counties¹, Lee County had the 11th highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,292**. Between 2018 and 2019, Lee County had the fifth largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at **.8** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

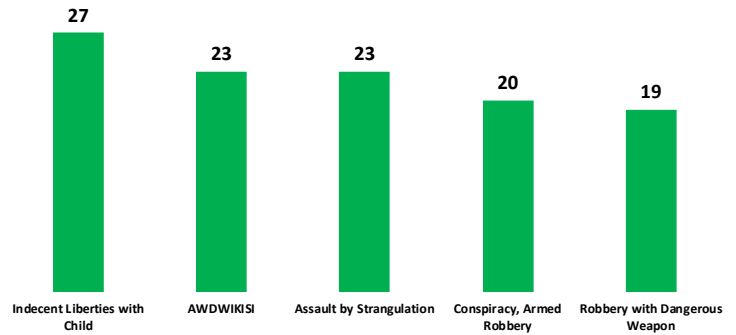


Among micropolitan counties¹, Lee County had the 14th lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **5,399**. Lee County had the 13th lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **36**.

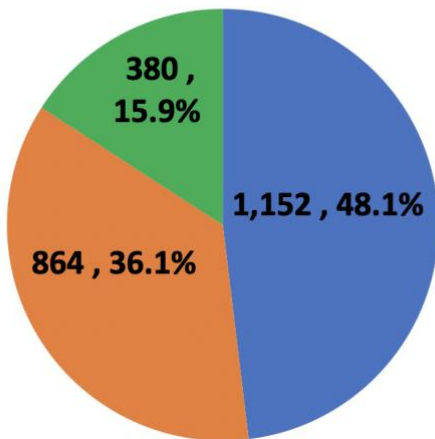
¹ Micropolitan counties are counties in micropolitan statistical areas, which are defined by the Office of Management and Budget as having a core concentrated population of at least 10,000 and less than 50,000.

15.9% of Lee County felony charges were for violent felonies, **36.1%** were for nonviolent drug felonies, and **48.1%** were for other nonviolent felonies.

Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

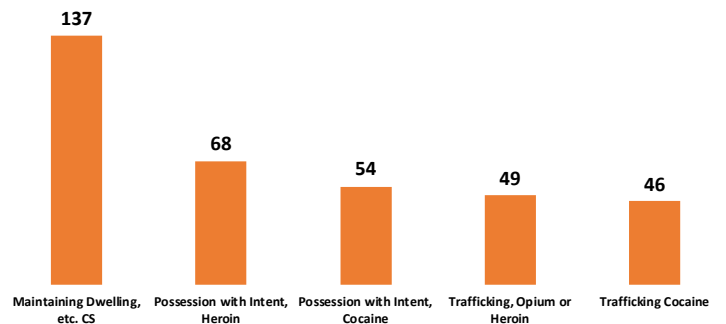

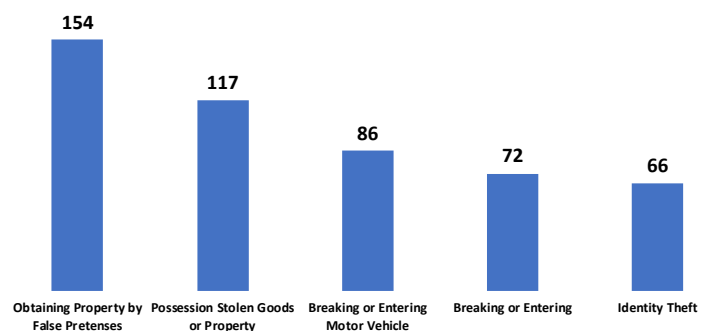

Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies

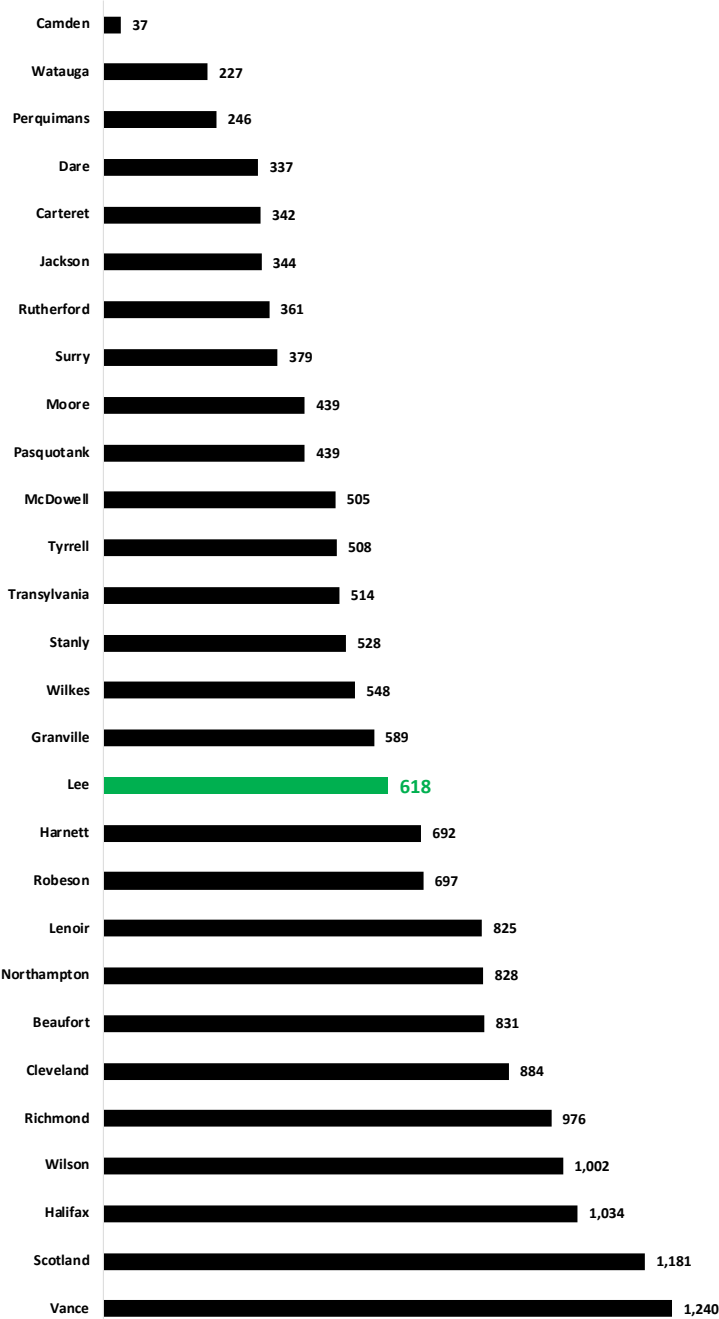

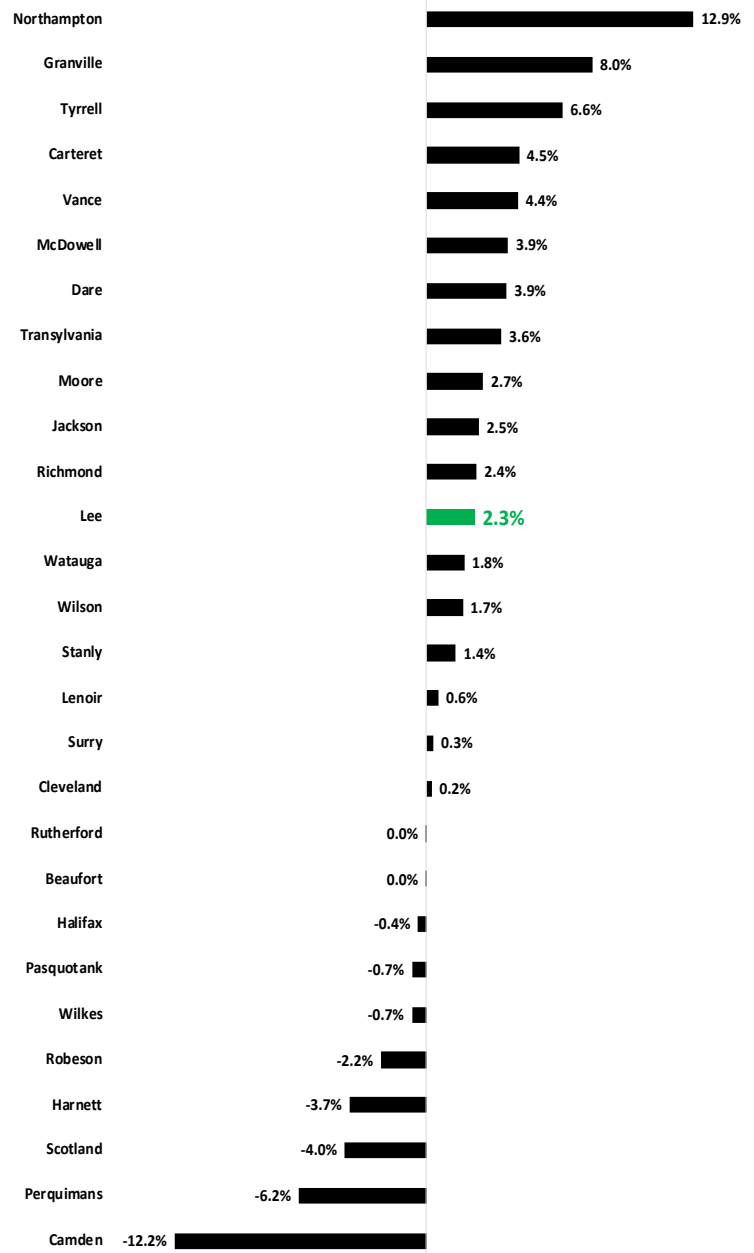


Among micropolitan counties¹, Lee County had the 12th highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **618**. Between 2018 and 2019, Lee County had the 12th largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **2.3** percentage points.
