




Nonviolent, Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanor Charges




Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors







2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties




18.8% of Lenoir County felony charges were for violent felonies, 30.8% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 50.4% were for other nonviolent felonies.

Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies



2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies
