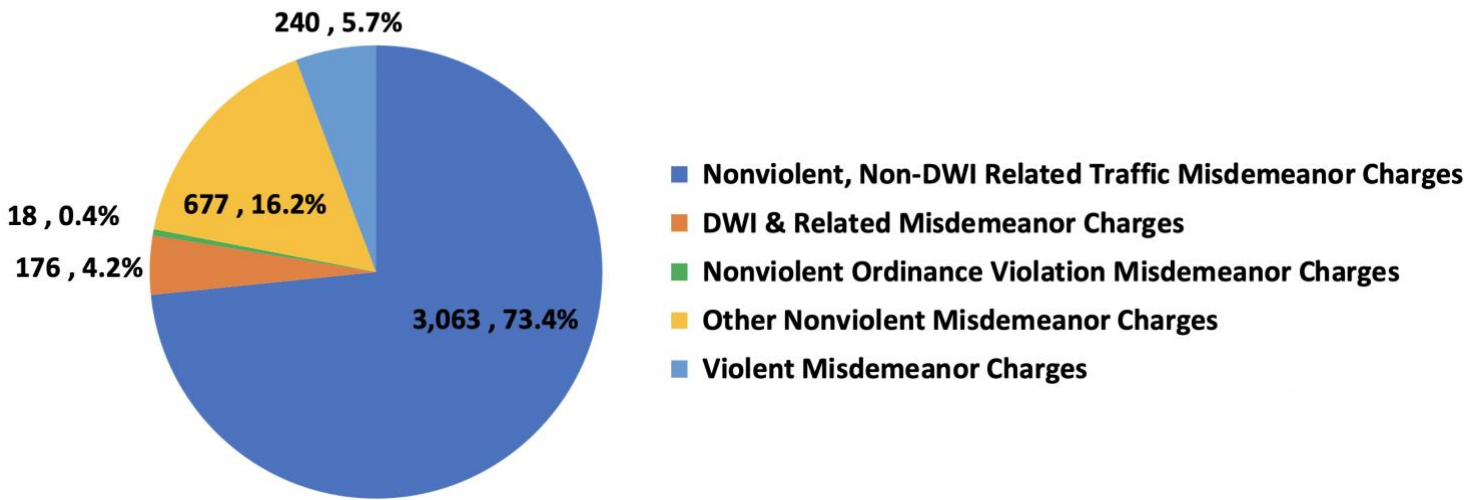
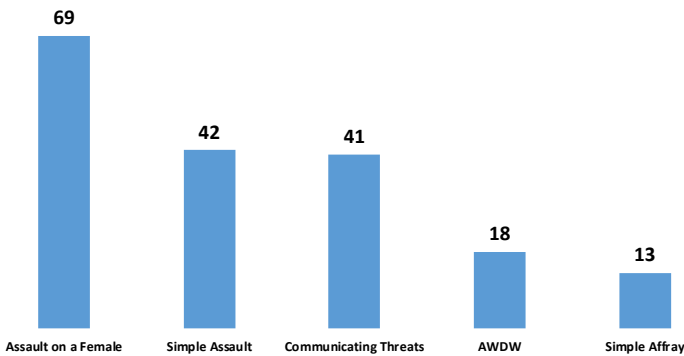


73.4% of Martin County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 16.2% were for other nonviolent offenses, 4.2% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.7% were for violent offenses, and .4% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

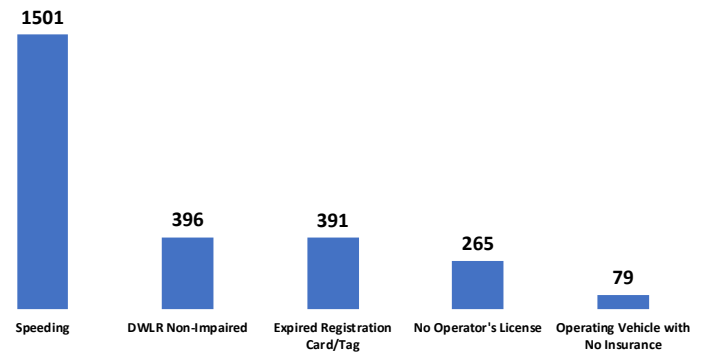
### 2019 Charged Misdemeanors



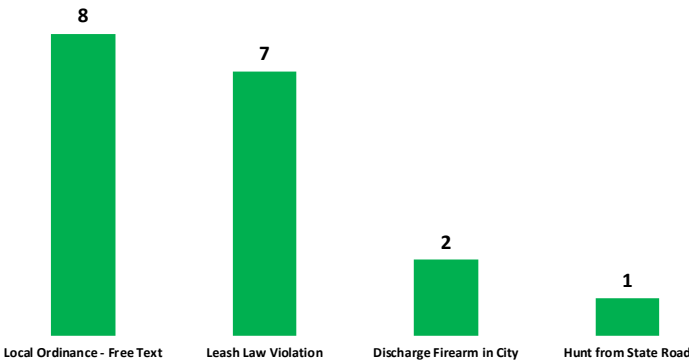
Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



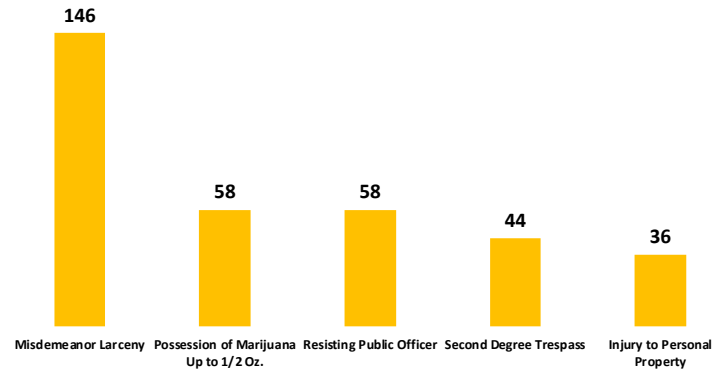
Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



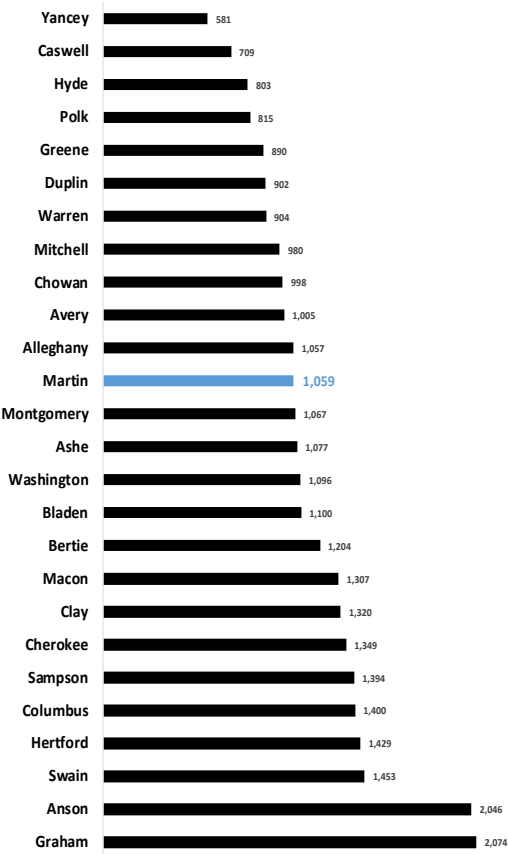
Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



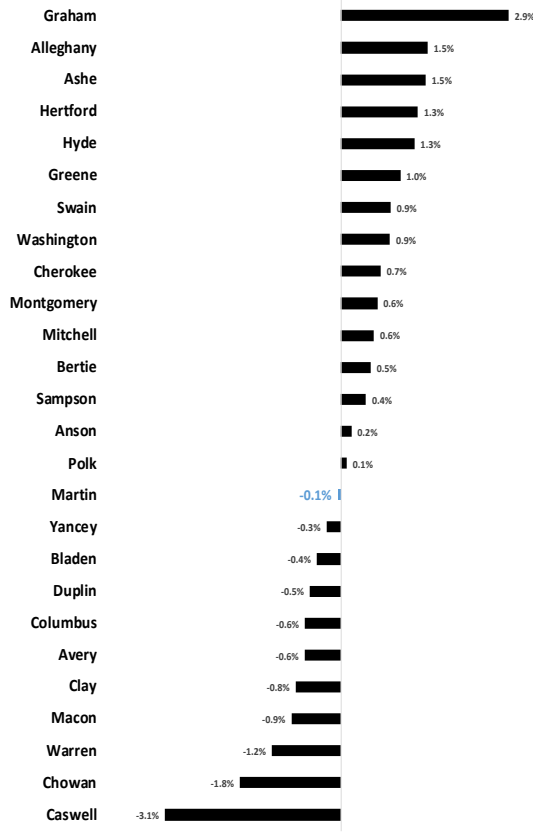
Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors



2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

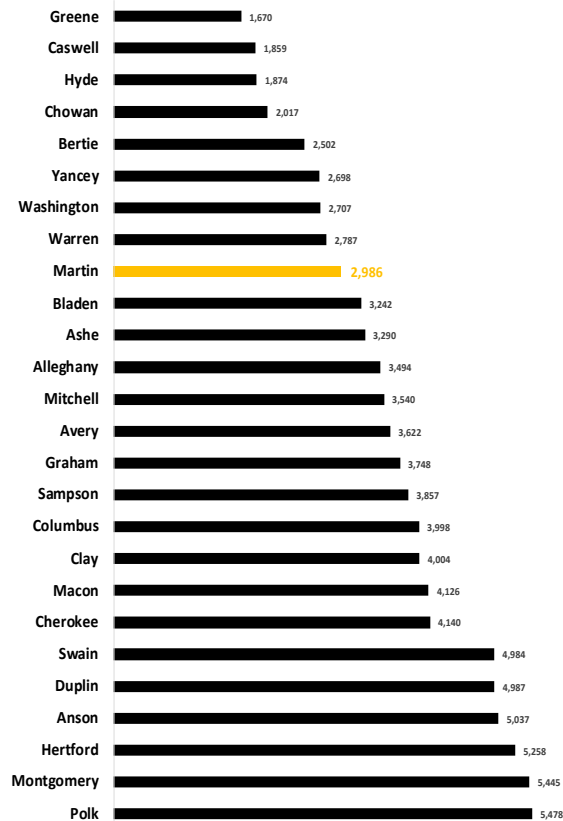


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties

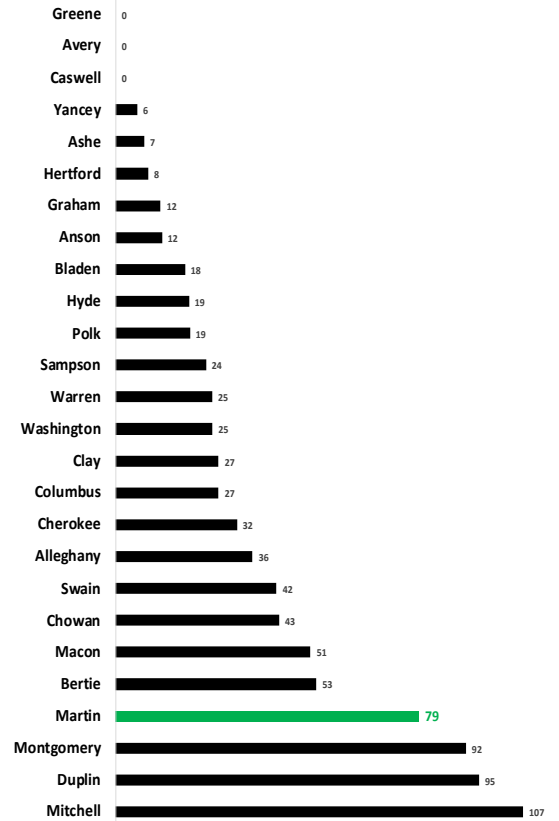


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Martin County had the 12<sup>th</sup> lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,059**. Between 2018 and 2019, Martin County had the 11<sup>th</sup> largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at **.1** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

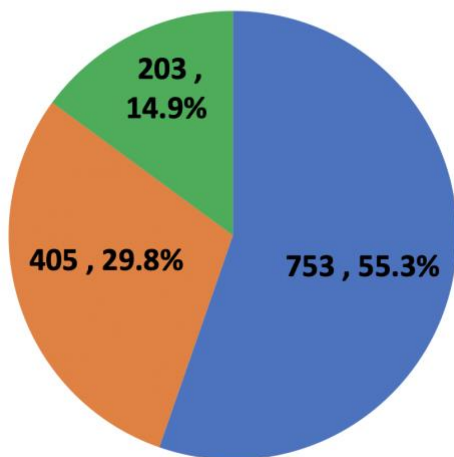


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Martin County had the ninth lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **2,986**. Martin County had the fourth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **79**.

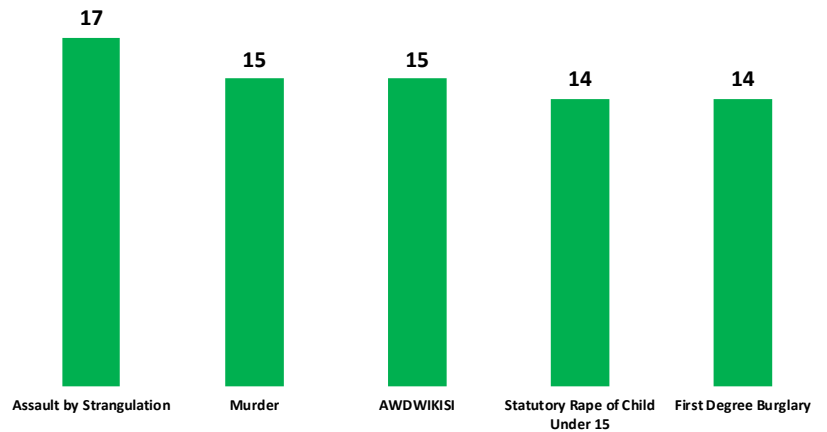
14.9% of Martin County felony charges were for violent felonies, 29.8% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 55.3% were for other nonviolent felonies.

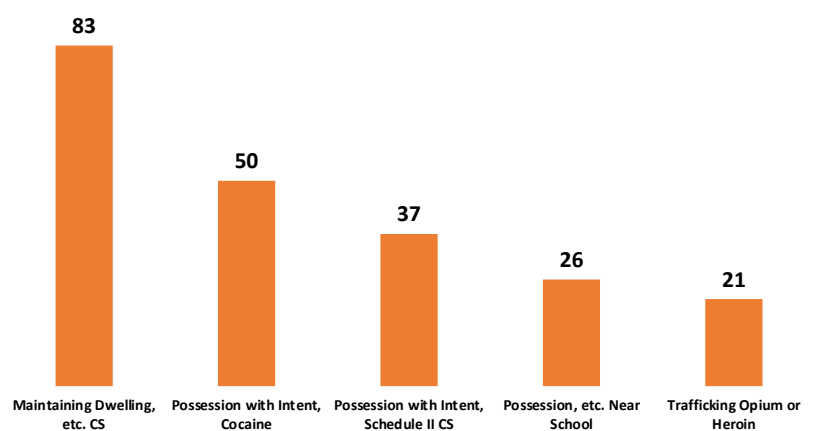

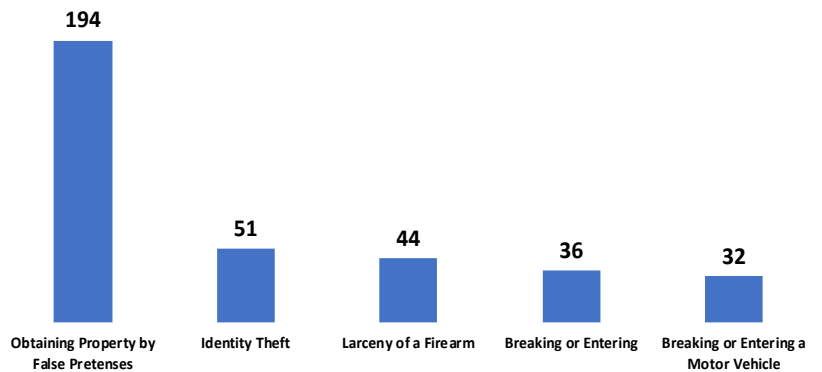
#### Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Martin County had the third highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **895**. Between 2018 and 2019, Martin County had the 10<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **.7** percentage points.
