


73.4% of Martin County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **16.2%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.2%** were for DWI and related offenses, **5.7%** were for violent offenses, and **.4%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.







Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Speeding DWLR Non-Impaired Expired Registration No Operator's License Operating Vehicle with No Insurance





2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among noncore counties¹, Martin County had the 12th lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,059**. Between 2018 and 2019, Martin County had the 11th largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at **.1** percentage points.

2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties


2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties




14.9% of Martin County felony charges were for violent felonies, 29.8% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 55.3% were for other nonviolent felonies.



Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies


2019 Charged Felonies





Among noncore counties¹, Martin County had the third highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 895. Between 2018 and 2019, Martin County had the 10th largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at .7 percentage points.
