


**Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors** 




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




**Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations** 




**Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors** 






## 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Mitchell County had the eighth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 980. Between 2018 and 2019, Mitchell County had the 11th largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .6 percentage points.


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Mitchell County had the 13<sup>th</sup> lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,540. Mitchell County had the highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 107.




13.4% of Mitchell County felony charges were for violent felonies, 47.8% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 38.8% were for other nonviolent felonies.



**Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies** 







## **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**



Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Mitchell County had the fifth lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 287. Between 2018 and 2019, Mitchell County had the sixth largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at 2.3 percentage points.
