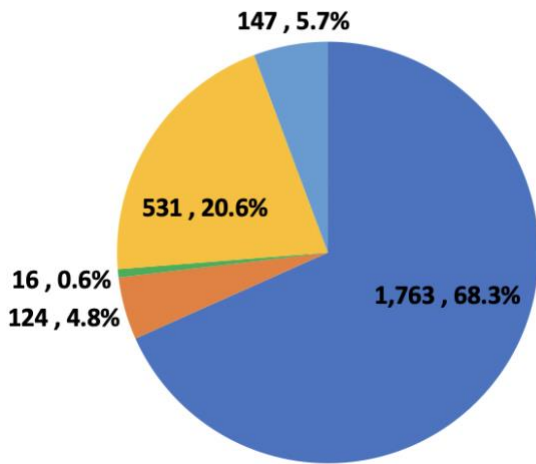


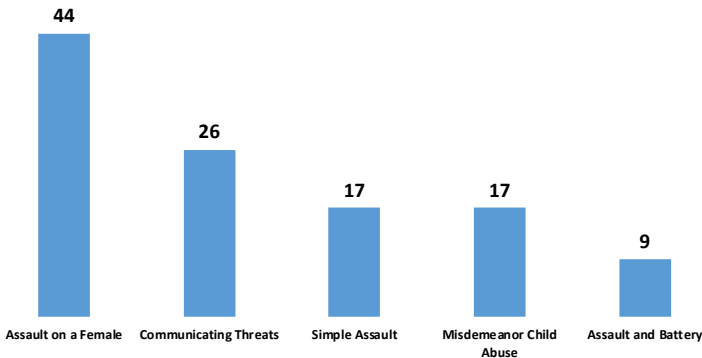
68.3% of Mitchell County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 20.6% were for other nonviolent offenses, 4.8% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.7% were for violent offenses, and .6% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

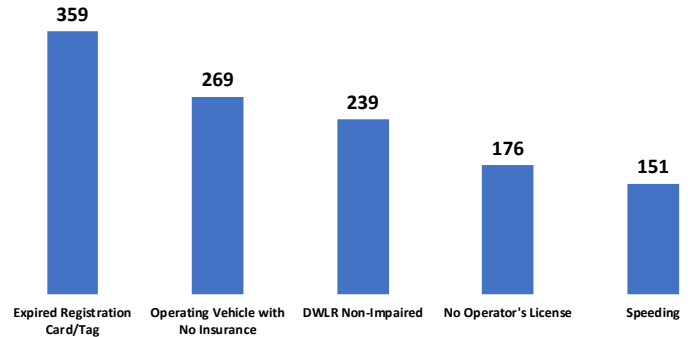

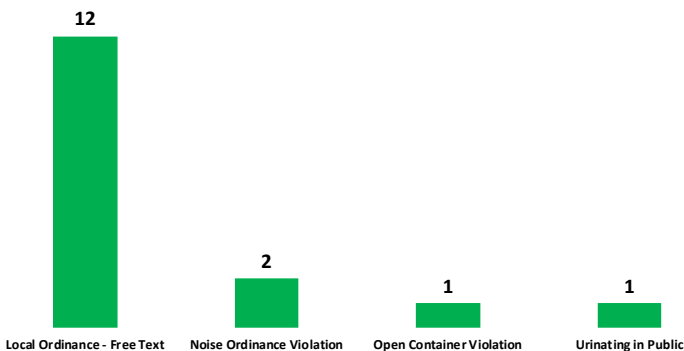
### Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



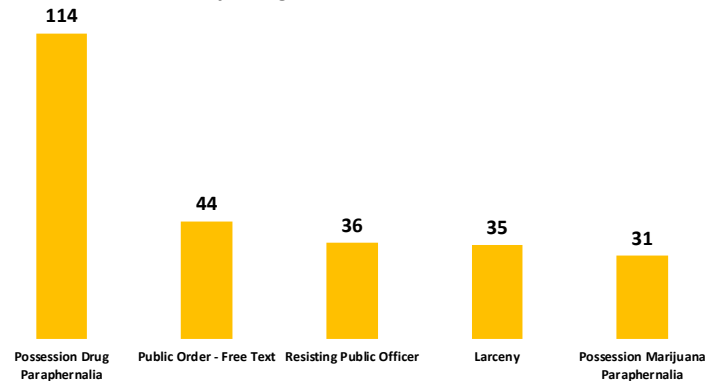
### Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



### Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



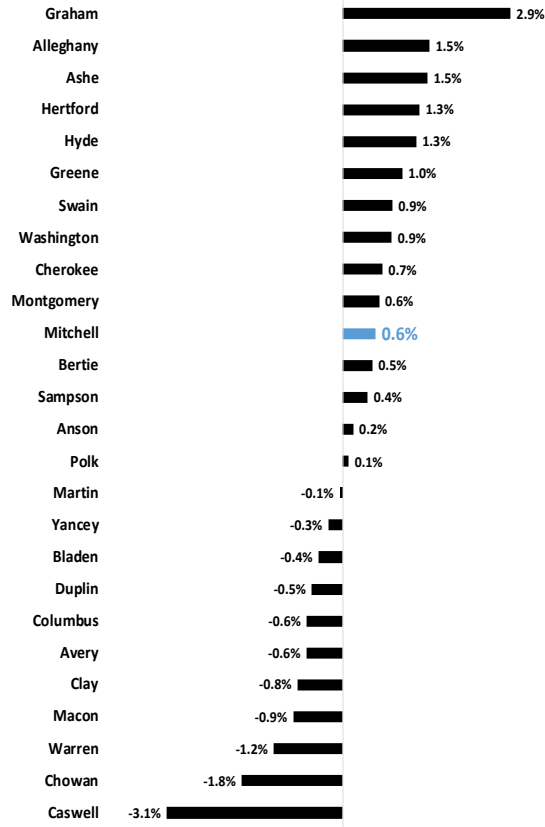
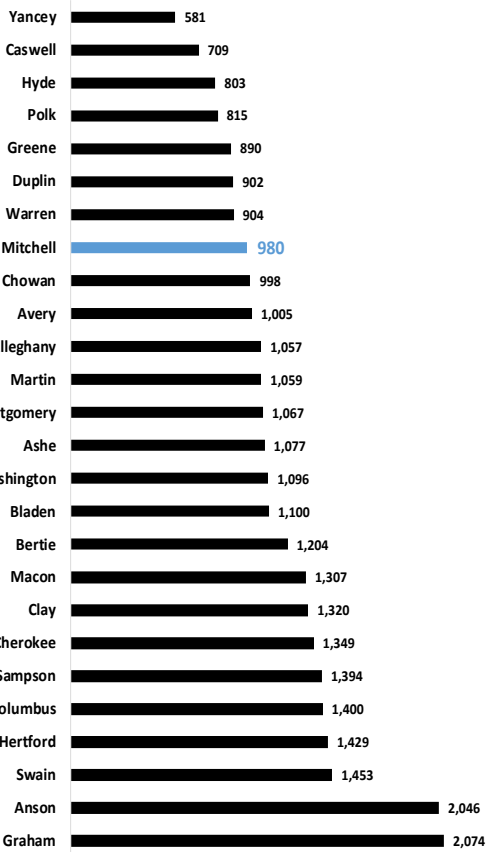

2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties

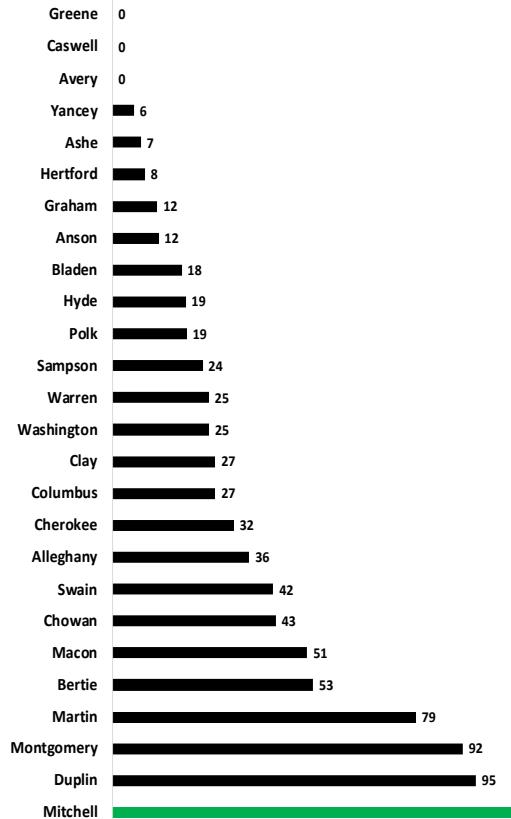
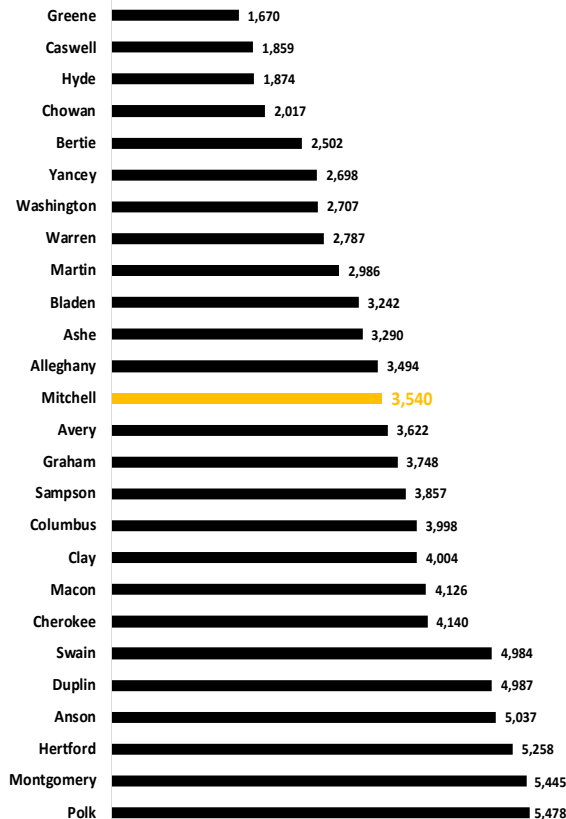
Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Mitchell County had the eighth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **980**. Between 2018 and 2019, Mitchell County had the 11<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at **.6** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

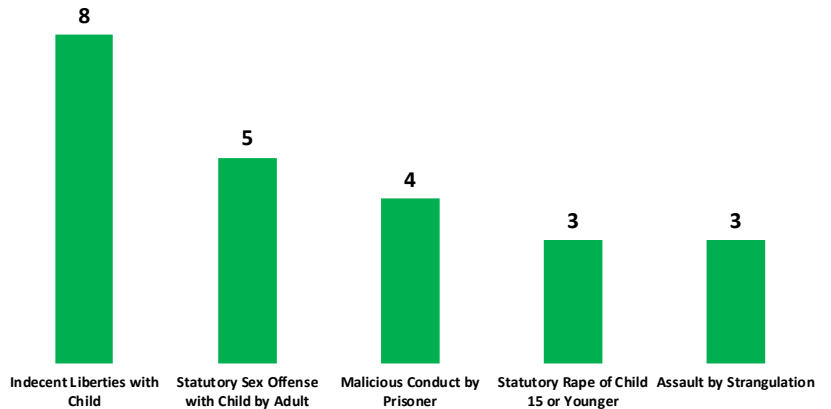
Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Mitchell County had the 13<sup>th</sup> lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **3,540**. Mitchell County had the highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **107**.



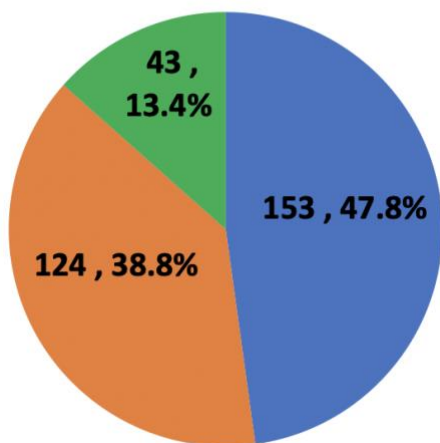

13.4% of Mitchell County felony charges were for violent felonies, 47.8% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 38.8% were for other nonviolent felonies.

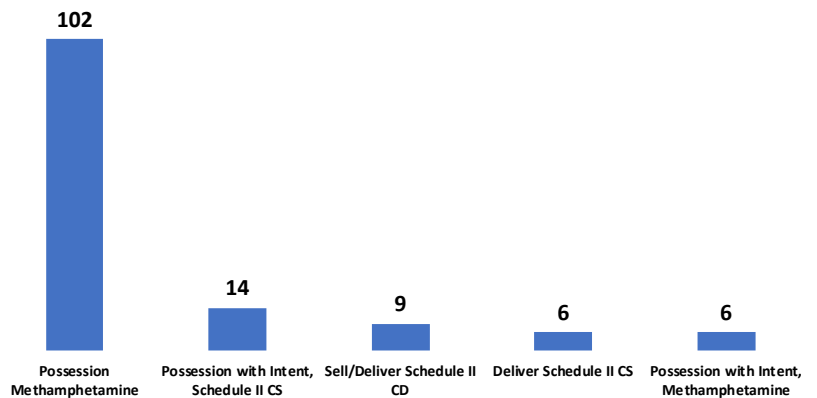
Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

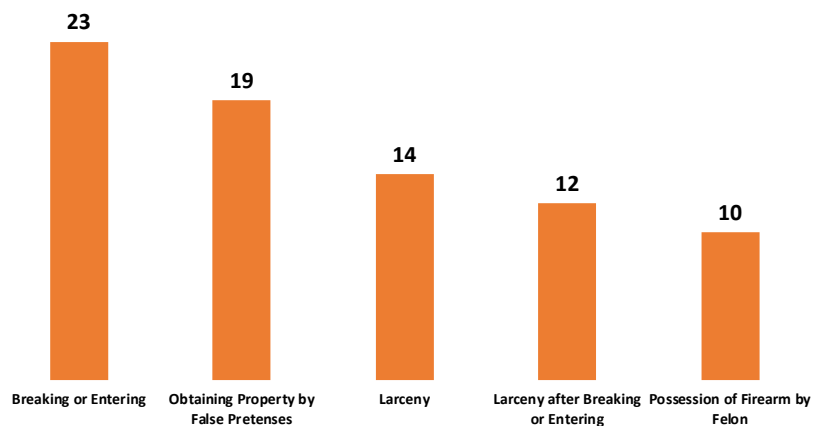


Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies



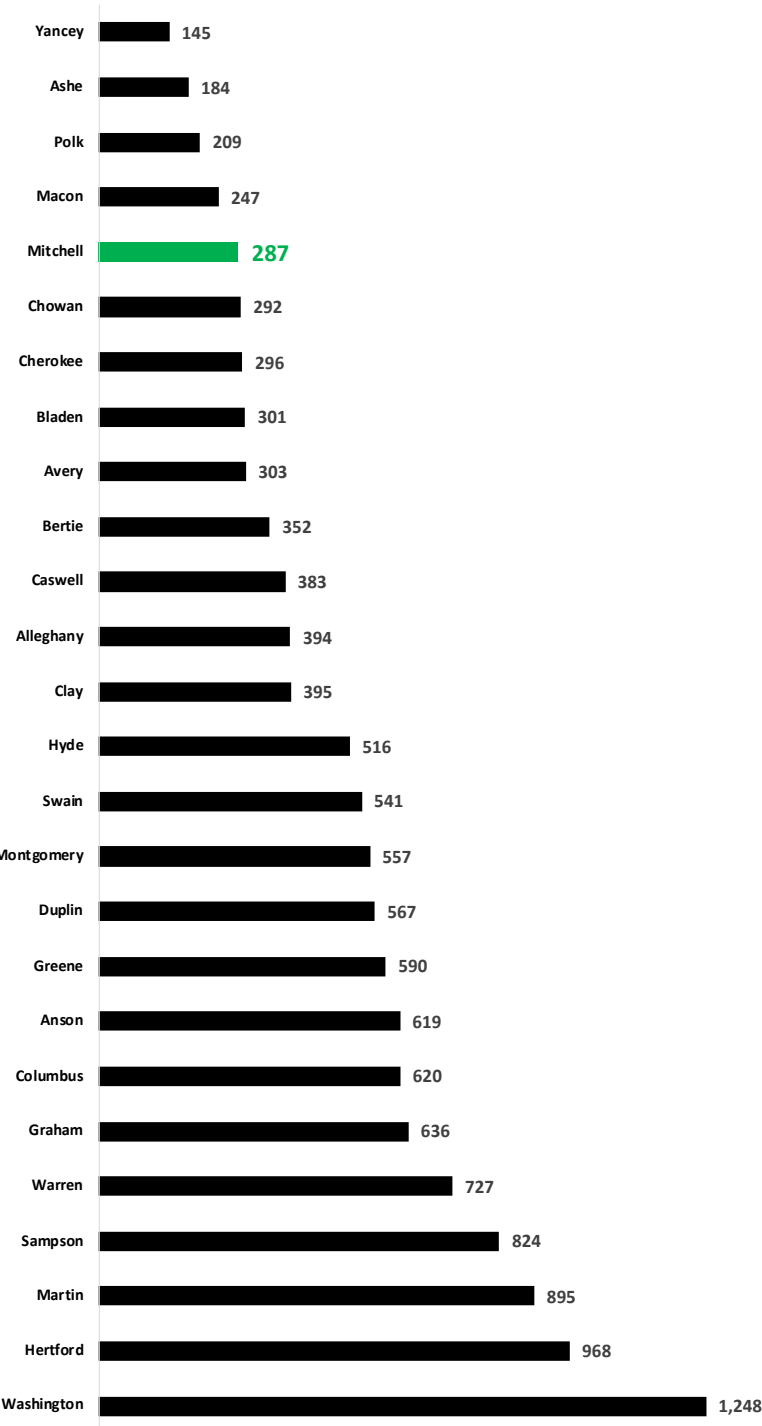

Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies

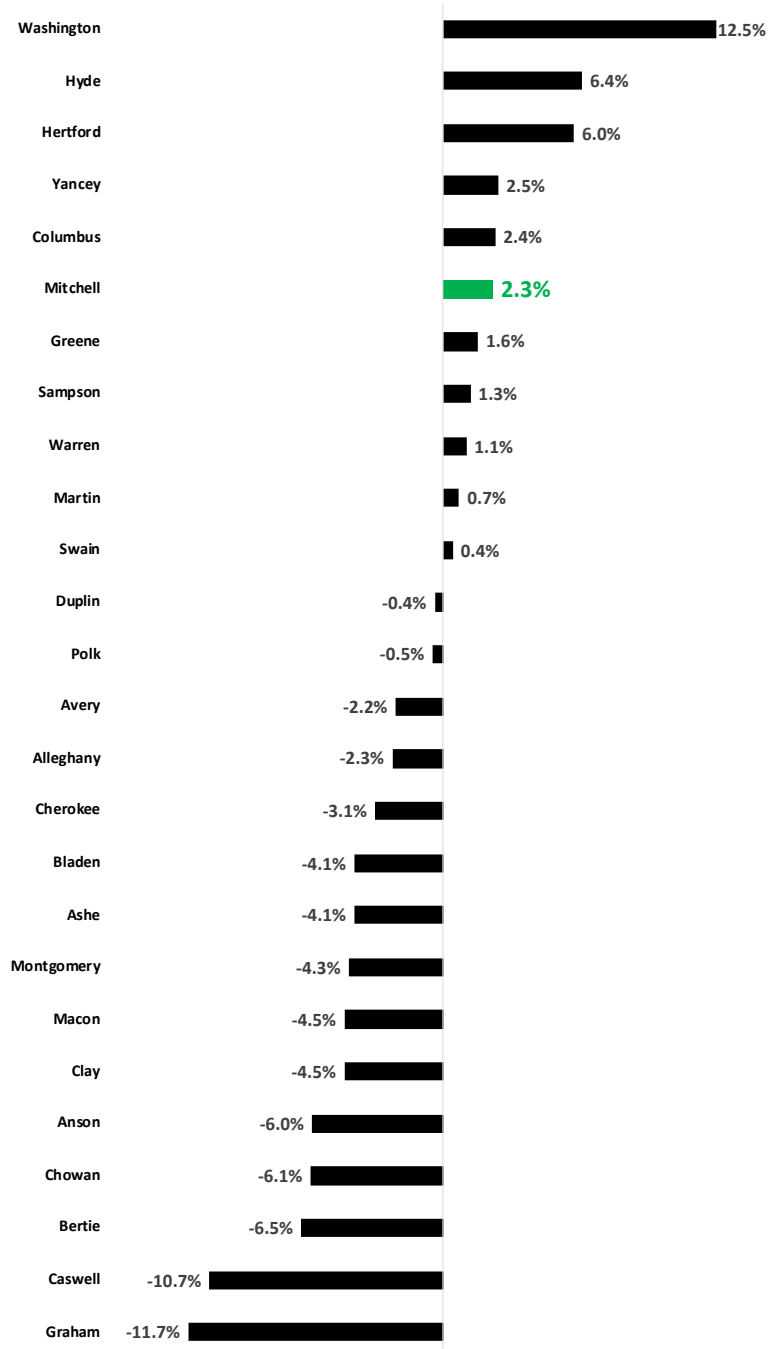


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Mitchell County had the fifth lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **287**. Between 2018 and 2019, Mitchell County had the sixth largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **2.3** percentage points.
