


69.7% of Moore County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 21.3% were for other nonviolent offenses, 2.9% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.8% were for violent offenses, and .3% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

■ Nonviolent, Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanor Charges






Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors




2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among micropolitan counties¹, Moore County had the sixth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,005**. Between 2018 and 2019, Moore County had the 11th largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at .6 percentage points.

County had the ninth lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,718. Moore County had the 14th highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 50.







2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties








10.5% of Moore County felony charges were for violent felonies, 35.3% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 54.2% were for other nonviolent felonies.




2019 Charged Felonies






- Nonviolent Felonies, Other

Among micropolitan counties¹, Moore County had the ninth lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 439. Between 2018 and 2019, Moore County had the ninth largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at 2.7 percentage points.
