



69.7% of Nash County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **18.9%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.5%** were for DWI and related offenses, **6.2%** were for violent offenses, and **.7%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

2019 Charged Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors





Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors











Among small metro counties¹, Nash County had the fifth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,194**. Between 2018 and 2019, Nash County had the second largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .5 percentage points.


Among small metro counties¹, Nash County had the second lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,325. Nash County had the highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 137.








13.8% of Nash County felony charges were for violent felonies, 32.0% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 54.2% were for other nonviolent felonies.




2019 Charged Felonies
