




Nonviolent, Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanor Charges




Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors





Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations











Among small metro counties¹, Onslow County had the lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 818. Between 2018 and 2019, Onslow County had the largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .7 percentage points.





2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies
