




**75.1%** of Orange County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **13.9%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **5.4%** were for DWI and related offenses, **4.8%** were for violent offenses, and **.8%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.











# 2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Medium Metro Counties

### 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Medium Metro Counties



Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, **Orange County had** the lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 687. Between 2018 and 2019, Orange County had the 8th largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .4 percentage points.

Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Orange County had the lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,991. Orange County had the fourth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 116.




2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000






## **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**



Among medium metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Orange County had the 5<sup>th</sup> lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **279**. Between 2018 and 2019, Orange County had the 3rd largest decrease in violent felony charges among medium metro counties at **-6.2** percentage points.
