

**50.9%** of Pamlico County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **36.4%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.1%** were for DWI and related offenses, and **8.7%** were for violent offenses.





Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors











Among small metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Pamlico County had the fourth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,129. Between 2018 and 2019, Pamlico County had the largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at 1.7 percentage points.


Among small metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Pamlico County had the second highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,743. Pamlico County had the lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 0.








## 2019 Charged Felonies






**Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies** 





Among small metro counties<sup>1</sup>, Pamlico County had the second lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **324**. Between 2018 and 2019, Pamlico County had the second largest decrease in violent felony charges at **1.2** percentage points.
