





Among medium metro counties¹, Pender County had the eighth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 930. Between 2018 and 2019, Pender County had the largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at 2.9 percentage points.

Among medium metro counties¹, Pender County had the sixth lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,606. Pender County had the 10th lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **87**.









17.1% of Pender County felony charges were for violent felonies, 36.4% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 46.5% were for other nonviolent felonies.



2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies
