



71.2% of Perquimans County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **16.5%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **6.1%** were for DWI and related offenses, **6.0%** were for violent offenses, and **.1%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.


2019 Charged Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors








Among micropolitan counties1, **Perguimans County** had the fifth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 991. Between 2018 and 2019, **Perquimans County** had the third largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at 1.2 percentage points.









14.0% of Perquimans County felony charges were for violent felonies, 25.0% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 61.0% were for other nonviolent felonies.



2019 Charged Felonies








Among micropolitan counties¹, Perquimans County had the third lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 246. Between 2018 and 2019, Perquimans County had the second largest decrease in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at 6.2 percentage points.
