







Among medium metro counties¹, Person County had the seventh highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,278**. Between 2018 and 2019, Person County had the sixth largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .5 percentage points.

Among medium metro counties¹, Person County had the sixth highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,311. Person County had the 11th highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 63.






10.5% of Person County felony charges were for violent felonies, 67.6% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 21.8% were for other nonviolent felonies.







Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies



Among medium metro counties¹, Person County had the eighth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **524**. Between 2018 and 2019, Person County had the second largest decrease in violent felony charges among medium metro counties at **7.5** percentage points.
