



65.3% of Pitt County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 23.7% were for other nonviolent offenses, 3.7% were for DWI and related offenses, 6.9% were for violent offenses, and .3% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.






Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic





Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors











Among small metro counties¹, Pitt County had the fourth highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,194. Between 2018 and 2019, Pitt County had the fourth largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among medium metro counties at .4 percentage points.


Among small metro counties¹, Pitt
County had the third highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,500. Pitt County had the fourth lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 62.






16.7% of Pitt County felony charges were for violent felonies, 30.8% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 52.5% were for other nonviolent felonies.



2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies

Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies



Among small metro counties¹, Pitt County had the fourth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **758**. Between 2018 and 2019, Pitt County had the fifth largest increase in violent felony charges at **2.6** percentage points.
