



73.3% of Polk County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **20.4**% were for other nonviolent offenses, **3.3**% were for DWI and related offenses, **3.0**% were for violent offenses, and **0.1**% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.




Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors

2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties




Among noncore counties¹, Polk County had the fourth lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 815. Between 2018 and 2019, Polk County had the 15th largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .1 percentage points.


Among noncore counties¹, Polk






4.1% of Polk County felony charges were for violent felonies, **44.9%** were for nonviolent drug felonies, and **51.0%** were for other nonviolent felonies.


Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies




2019 Charged Felonies





Among noncore counties¹, Polk County had the third lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 209. Between 2018 and 2019, Polk County had the 14th largest decrease in violent felony charges among noncore counties at .5 percentage points.
