



Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors










2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor **Charges Among Noncore Counties**




Among micropolitan counties¹, Richmond County had the second highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,785. Between 2018 and 2019, Richmond County had the third largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at 1.0 percentage points.




2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100.000




2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population **Among Noncore Counties**








14.9% of Richmond County felony charges were for violent felonies, 38.0% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 47.1% were for other nonviolent felonies.




2019 Charged Felonies





Among micropolitan counties¹, Richmond County had the fifth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **976**. Between 2018 and 2019, Richmond County had the 11th largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **2.4** percentage points.
