

**53.3%** of Rutherford County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **35.7%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **3.0%** were for DWI and related offenses, **7.6%** were for violent offenses, and **.4%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.





Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations






Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic



2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population



2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties









Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Rutherford County had the seventh lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **361**. Between 2018 and 2019, Rutherford County had the 10<sup>th</sup> largest decrease in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **.03** percentage points.
