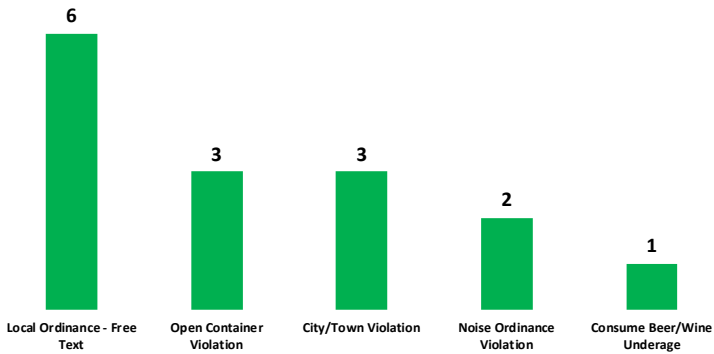


73.3% of Sampson County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 20.4% were for other nonviolent offenses, 3.3% were for DWI and related offenses, 3.0% were for violent offenses, and 0.1% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

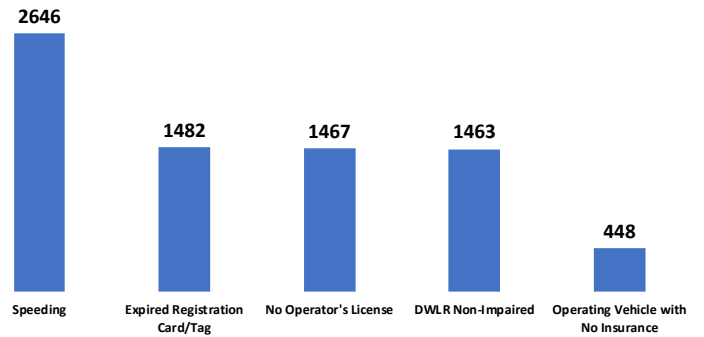
2019 Charged Misdemeanors



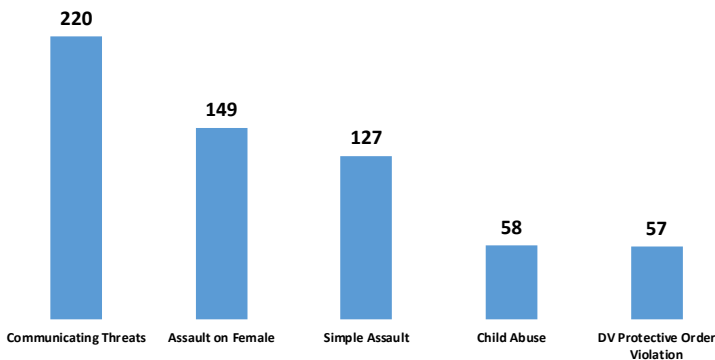
Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



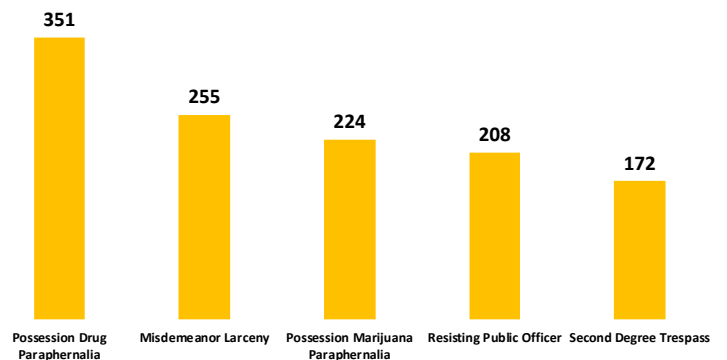
Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



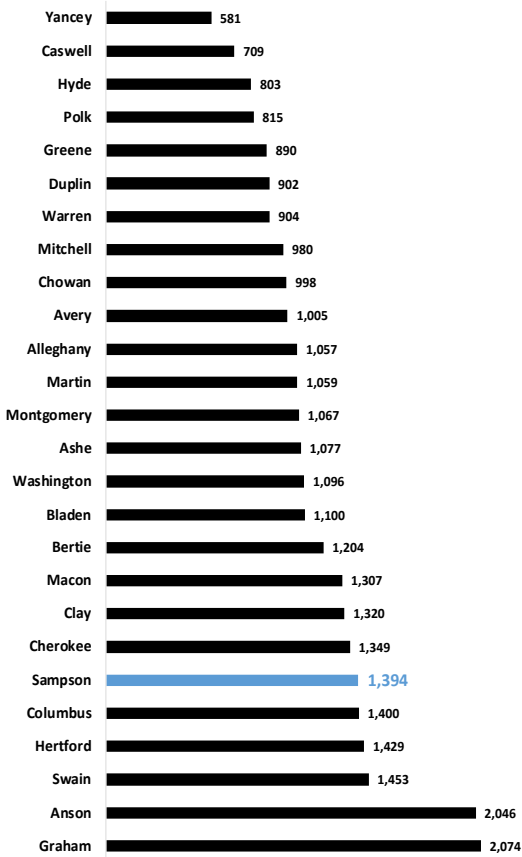
Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



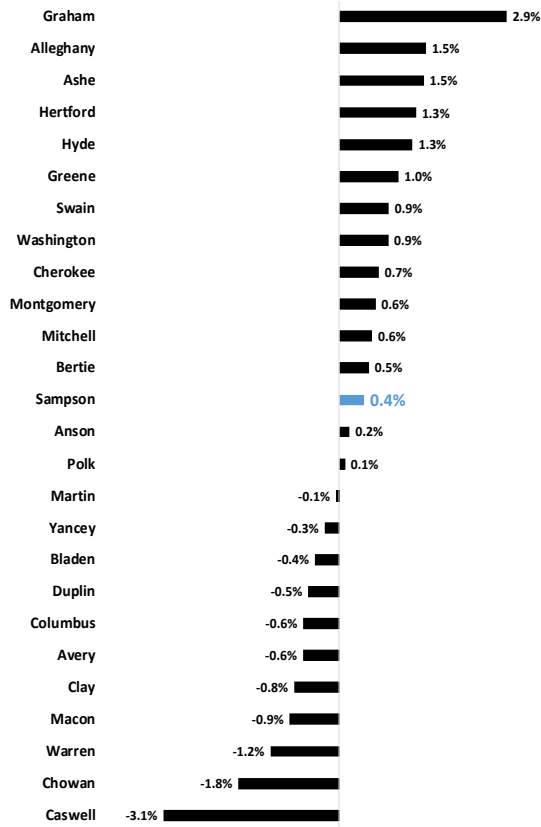
Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors



2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

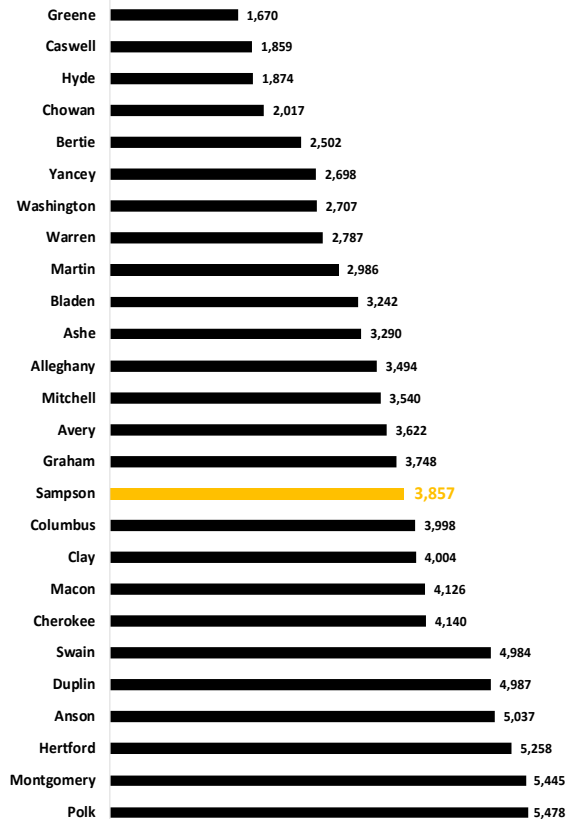


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties

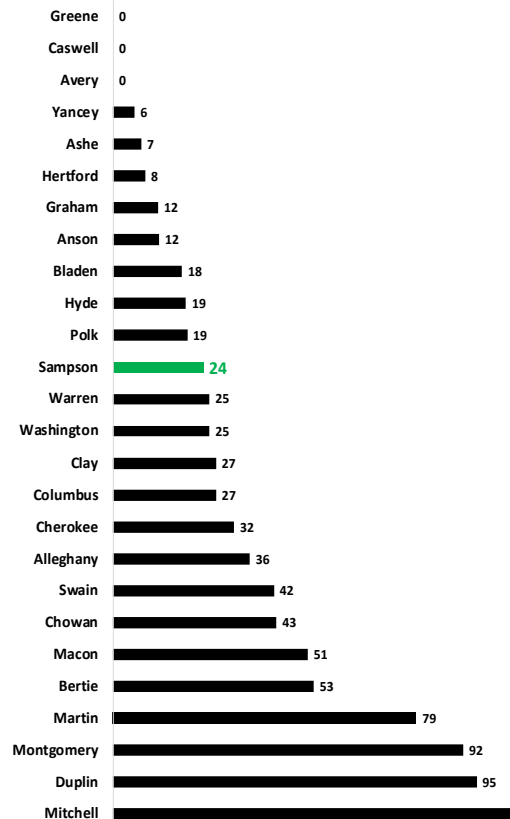


Among noncore counties¹, Sampson County had the sixth highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,394**. Between 2018 and 2019, Sampson County had the 13th largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at **.4** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

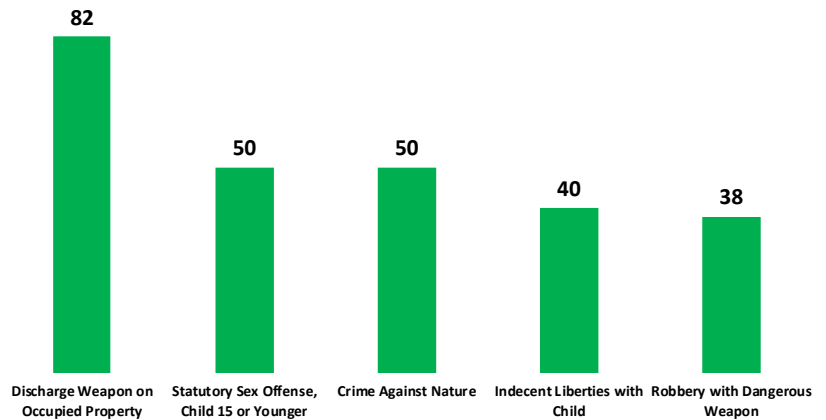


Among noncore counties¹, Sampson County had the 11th highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **3,857**. Sampson County had the 12th lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **24**.

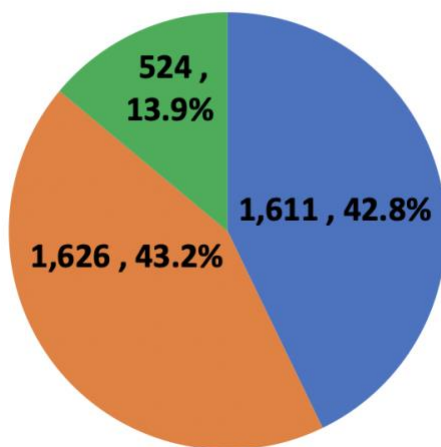

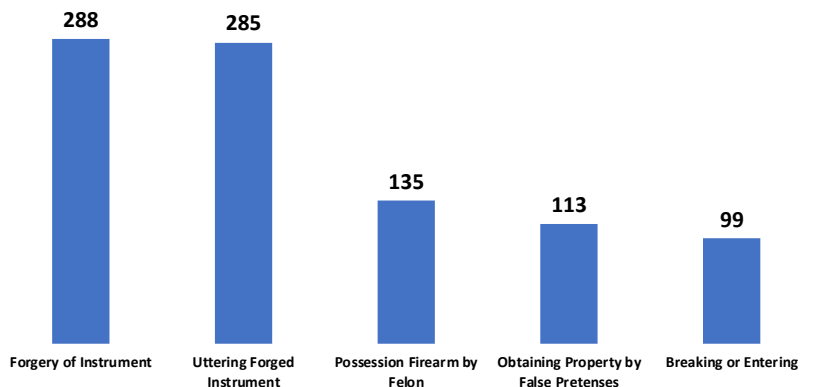

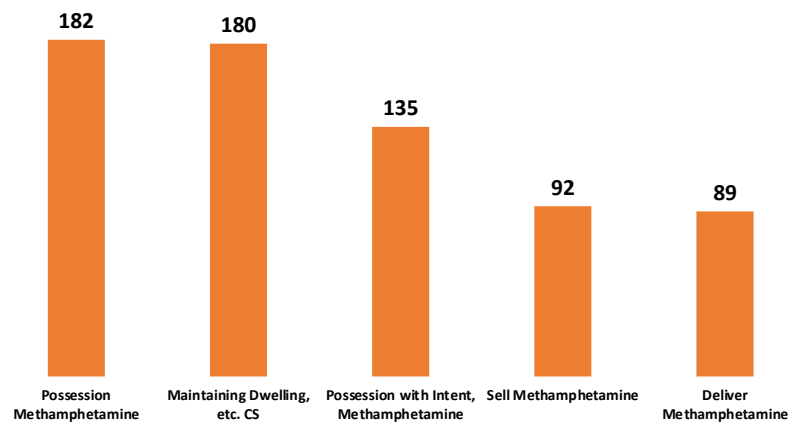

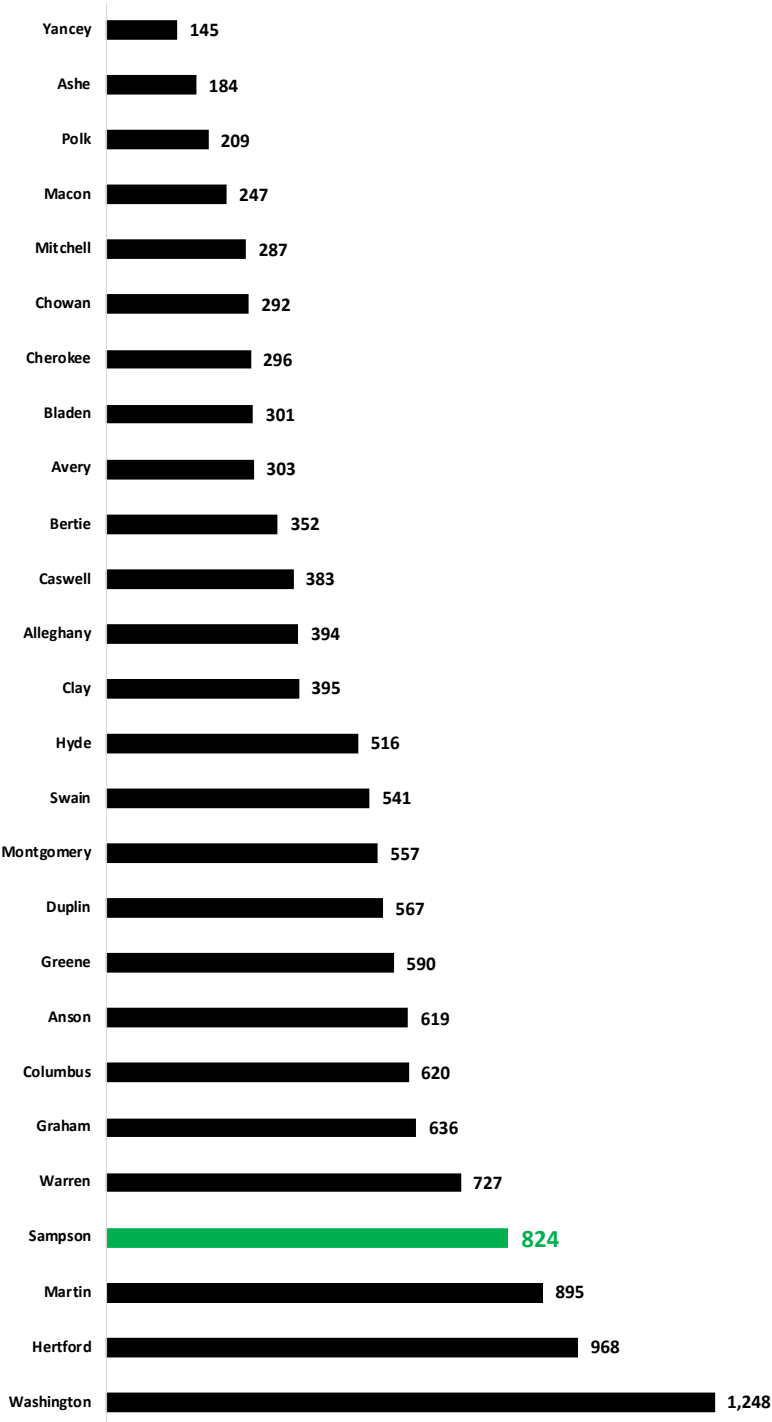

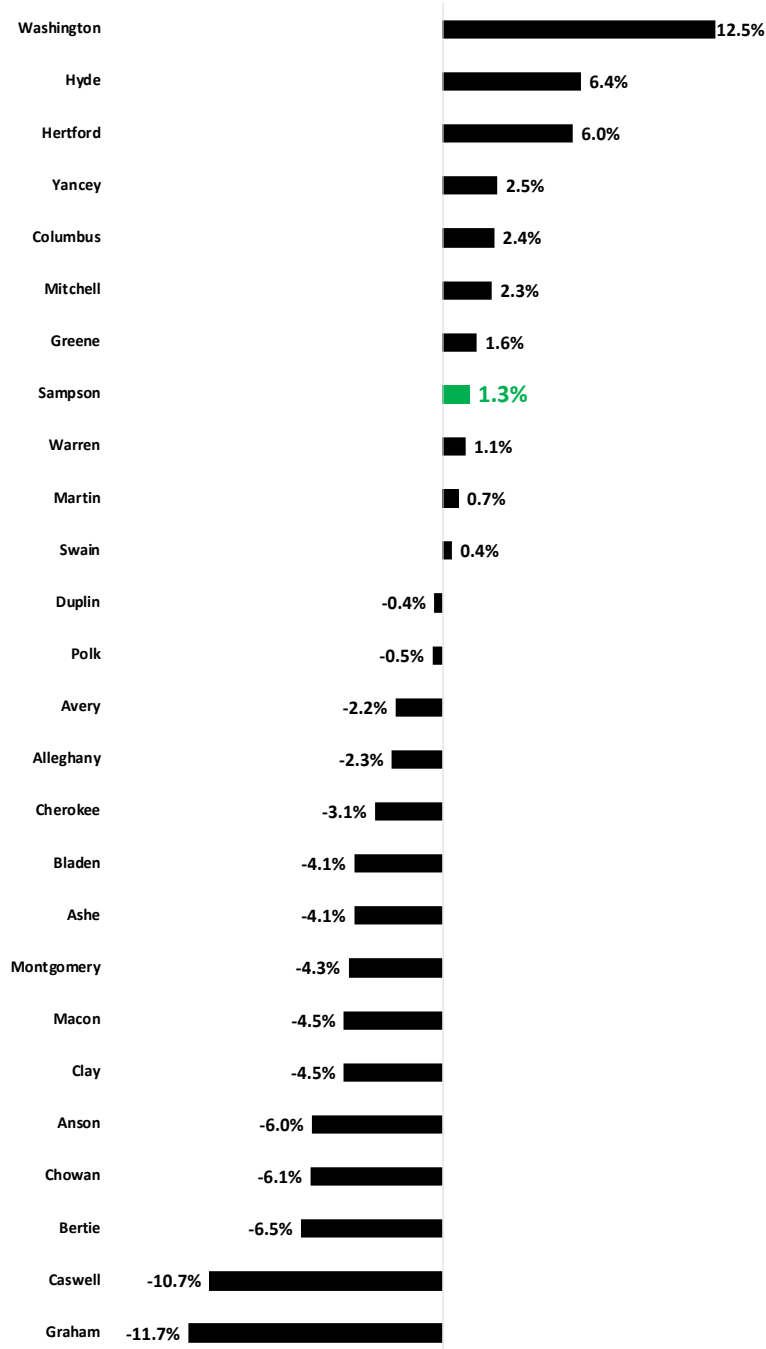


Among noncore counties¹, Sampson County had the fourth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **824**. Between 2018 and 2019, Sampson County had the eighth largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **1.3** percentage points.
