



**73.3**% of Sampson County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **20.4**% were for other nonviolent offenses, **3.3**% were for DWI and related offenses, **3.0**% were for violent offenses, and **0.1**% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.




#### **Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations**




#### Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



### **Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors**




#### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors**






#### 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Sampson County had the sixth highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,394. Between 2018 and 2019, Sampson County had the 13<sup>th</sup> largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .4 percentage points.


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Sampson County had the 11<sup>th</sup> highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,857. Sampson County had the 12<sup>th</sup> lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 24.






13.9% of Sampson County felony charges were for violent felonies, 43.2% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 42.8% were for other nonviolent felonies.






## **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**

Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Sampson County had the fourth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **824**. Between 2018 and 2019, Sampson County had the eighth largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **1.3** percentage points.
