




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors


2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among micropolitan counties¹, Scotland County had the highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 3,220. Between 2018 and 2019, Scotland County had the 12th largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at .4 percentage points.

Among micropolitan counties¹, Scotland County had the fifth highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 5,932. Scotland County had the sixth highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 109.







2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties










2019 Charged Felonies








Among micropolitan counties¹, Scotland County had the second highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,181**. Between 2018 and 2019, Scotland County had the third largest decrease in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **4.0** percentage points.
