


63.0% of Surry County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **26.2**% were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.3**% were for DWI and related offenses, **6.3**% were for violent offenses, and **.1**% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.








2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among micropolitan counties¹, Surry County had the 10th lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,104. Between 2018 and 2019, Surry County had the ninth largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at .6 percentage points.

Among micropolitan counties¹, Surry County had the 11th highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,610. Surry County had the seventh lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 24.






2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties






Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies


7.8% of Surry County felony charges were for violent felonies, **45.8%** were for nonviolent drug felonies, and **46.4%** were for other nonviolent felonies.




2019 Charged Felonies

Among micropolitan counties¹, Surry County had the eighth lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **379**. Between 2018 and 2019, Surry County had the 17th largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at .3 percentage points.
