






Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors





2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties










**Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies**
