



**52.4%** of Transylvania County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **33.5%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.2%** were for DWI and related offenses, **9.0%** were for violent offenses, and **1.0%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.






**Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors** 




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors











### 2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

#### 2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties



Among micropolitan counties1, Transylvania County had the ninth highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,339. Between 2018 and 2019, Transylvania County had the second largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at 2.2 percentage points.

## Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Transylvania County had the ninth highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 4,986. Transylvania County had the second highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 143.





2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100.000







17.4% of Transylvania County felony charges were for violent felonies, 38.9% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 43.7% were for other nonviolent felonies.





#### **Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies**



Among micropolitan counties<sup>1</sup>, Transylvania County had the 13<sup>th</sup> lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **514**. Between 2018 and 2019, Transylvania County had the eighth largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **3.6** percentage points.
