



82.3% of Tyrrell County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 12.5% were for other nonviolent offenses, 3.4% were for DWI and related offenses, and 1.7% were for violent offenses.




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors



2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Micropolitan Counties




2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Micropolitan Counties




Among micropolitan counties¹, Tyrrell County had the 13th highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,210**. Between 2018 and 2019, Tyrrell County had the 11th largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at **.4** percentage points.

2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Micropolitan Counties

Among micropolitan counties¹, Tyrrell County had the highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **8,715**. Tyrrell County had the lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **0**.




2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Micropolitan Counties





Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies





Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies






Among micropolitan counties¹, Tyrrell County had the 12th lowest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **508**. Between 2018 and 2019, Tyrrell County had the 3rd largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **6.6** percentage points.
